Host / Encampment Partnership Agreement

This agreement specifies the working partnership between <u>Holy Spirit Lutheran Church</u> (Host) and <u>Camp Unity Eastside</u> (Encampment). Its purpose is to clearly identify the commitments each party is making to ensure an effective partnership for all. This is in addition to meeting all the requirements specified by the local Temporary Use Permit ordinance.

Host will:

- Work as a partner with the Encampment and local government to provide a safe and secure site for encampment residents and the surrounding community.
- Provide suitable property for hosting the encampment.
- Pay the costs associated with securing an appropriate temporary use permit (fees, neighborhood mailings, hosting community meetings, etc.)
- Provide appropriate utility hookups to meet the needs of the encampment.
- Pay for the cost of utilities as needed by the encampment (water, sewer, electricity).
- Welcome encampment residents as they would any member of the general public who comes to their facility.
- Help encampment network for future hosting sites.
- When possible, interact with encampment at house meetings and share encouragement, needs, and concerns.

Encampment organization will:

- Work as a partner with the Host and local government to provide a safe and secure site for encampment residents and the surrounding community.
- Pay for these costs associated with operating the camp; garbage disposal, porta-potties, laundry.
- At the end permit period thoroughly clean the site area.
- Allow camp residents to interact with host and its members freely without fear of recourse or penalty, this includes attending worship services, classes, community meals, etc. Allow camp residents to be treated with dignity and respect like any other member of the general public who comes to the host facility.
- Provide a signed "Letter of Intent to Host" from an appropriate organization that will be hosting the encampment at the end of the permit period. Under all circumstances the encampment agrees to move out at the end of the permit period.
- Provide a written copy of Encampment's Code of Conduct and the procedure for dealing with violations.
- Be responsive to host needs and provide volunteers to help when and if needed.
