Payment Terms:

Space in class will be reserved upon submission of this Agreement and payment of registration fee.

Registration for the class commits the student and family to the full nine-month course fees.

Payment is due the first of each month, September through May. Payments received after the 7th of the month, will be assessed a \$25 late fee. Returned checks will be assessed a \$35 fee.
