AIRPORT REGULATIONS

All gels, liquids, and aerosols must be packed in containers of three ounces or less and put into a single, quart-size, clear plastic zip-top bag. If you have any meds or items that do not fit in the quart-size bag, you must show it to security officers at the checkpoint. For more info, go to **TSA.gov**.

LEAK PREVENTION

Liquids or gels tend to leak due to changing air pressure and temperature. Try filling a container a little more than $^3/_4$ full to limit air space, or squeeze the container while screwing on a cap; you'll give the contents in the container room to spread out. You should put all containers in plastic bags just in case. Shop online for appropriately sized, leak-free bottles.
