

*If you earn a "C" as a final grade in any DE course, you may not participate in any other DE course at DASH, FIU, or MDC as a high school student.

*DE courses appear on your high school transcript and, in some cases, your college transcript.

- Per DASH administration, <u>4 AP course load maximum</u>. AP Art classes count toward max.
- * AP recommendations can be adjusted in accordance with student performance.
- * Students enrolled in an AP course must take the AP exam for that course.
- * All Senior students must submit an AP portfolio for each AP Art class.
