XI. COURSE EVALUATION

COURSE EVALUATION

- The Task Force Medical Team Training Course is a vital element of the total training cycle.
- It is essential that the course be of the highest caliber possible in order to ensure standardized procedures among all task forces in the system and to provide the basic materials for providing Medical Team training to the balance of task force personnel nationwide.
- Individual lesson evaluations will be conducted at the conclusion of each classroom and field exercise.
- The overall course evaluation and critique will be held at the conclusion of the course and will be used to refine the Medical Team Training materials and presentations for future courses.

EVALUATION PROCESS

The following process will be used for completing the course evaluation:

- All participants will complete the individual course evaluation form.
- Participants will break up into their assigned work groups and summarize their comments onto a single group evaluation form.
- A group-appointed spokesperson will present three (3) key issues (strengths or weaknesses) during the general evaluation session. Inputs will be highlighted on an easel.
- The course coordinator, together with administrative support personnel, will consolidate all comments/suggestions and develop a summary matrix.
- The course summary will be submitted to the FEMA US&R Advisory Committee for review.
- The course will be modified, as appropriate.
