About Five Hole Hockey

Five Hole Hockey was founded in 2006 with the goal of helping amateur hockey players develop their skills, pursue advanced and elite levels of hockey, and to help players further themselves as individuals through the game of hockey. Head Instructor: Andy Holmes

A founder of Five Hole Hockey, Andy is a Level 4 Certified USA Hockey Coach and currently runs the hockey operations for Five Hole Hockey. He brings over 30 years of playing and coaching experience to our organization. He has worked with players of all ages, abilities, and positions.

In addition to his role with Five hole Hockey, Andy serves as an instructor for The Goalie Academy, coaches in the Philadelphia Jr. Flyers Tier 1 youth hockey program, and assists elite level junior programs with their scouting. He believes in developing a strong fundamental skill set along with a love of the game in today's young players.

As a player, Andy started in the Hershey Youth Hockey program and went on to play Division 1 Prep School hockey at Choate. After completing high school, he played 3 years of junior hockey in the U.S. & Canada completing his playing career with a stint in the minor leagues. His educational background includes a B.S. degree as well as an M.B.A.

Program Philosophy:

Five Hole Hockey strongly believes that the future of the game is our young players. This program is designed to take place in a small-group setting and is built around these key areas:

- 1. Fundamental Skill Development & Skill Progression
- 2. Low Coach to Player Ratio Emphasizing Teaching
- 3. Teaching Basic Hockey Knowledge
- 4. Teaching Basic Hockey Concepts
- 5. Having Fun While Learning & Competing

Areas of Emphasis:

Skill, skills, and more skills – Summer is the time to focus on a player's individual skill set, both on its development and on its progression. We will emphasize teaching proper form and technique in key fundamental areas – skating, puck handling, passing, and shooting in an age and skill level appropriate manner.

Basic Hockey Knowledge – we will focus on learning the areas of the ice, responding to whistles in a practice setting, and learning the basic concepts of offensive play/situations and defensive play/situations.

Basic Hockey Concepts – learning to enjoy competition and teaching the concept of team play.

Program Goal: Player Improvement While Having Fun!

Development, development, development! Developing hockey players is our goal. We will help every player learn and grow in their abilities on the ice all while challenging them consistently in a fun, positive atmosphere!

Five Hole Hockey, L.L.C. Waiver and Release From Liability

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any athletic/sports events sponsored by **Five Hole Hockey, L.L.C.**, and any related events and activities, and intending to be legally bound, the undersigned:

- 1. Agree that the parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s) will instruct the minor participant that prior to participating he or she should inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if the participant believes anything is unsafe, he or she should immediately advise his or her coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
- 2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability, and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used.
