Noun designates someone or something. This can include ideas.

Pronoun takes the place of a noun. *He, she, me, your, his, this, that, which, who, someone, anything, nobody, etc...*

Verb expresses the action or state of being; tells what the noun is doing or

did.

Adjective a word that modifies a noun.

Adverb a word that modifies a verb.

Preposition a word like *in, on, by, to,* or *around* when it introduces a noun,

pronoun, or noun, phrase.

Conjunction joins two grammatical elements of the same kind. FANBOYS: *for, and,*

nor, but, or, yet, so.

Interjection an exclamation.
