Financial Guidelines for Missions Projects/Trips

Short-term missions provide an opportunity for direct ministry participation in unique and challenging ministry fields. Fund-raising projects help meet the needs of individuals who sense God's call to take part in mission opportunities. All fund-raising efforts associated with the project reflect the Christ-honoring stewardship that is a hallmark of First Baptist Church.

These guidelines must be followed for all FBC sponsored mission projects....

- Fund-raising must have Missions Committee approval before it is implemented.
- No funds will be spent based on anticipated contributions. The entire cost of the project
 must be deposited in the designated project fund <u>before</u> any travel arrangements or
 commitments can be made.
- All fund-raising must be directed toward the support of a specific project or ministry effort.
- Fund-raising must reflect favorably upon the church and not cause the community to regard our congregation in a negative fashion. It must never compromise Christian principles of stewardship and character.
- Fund-raising must be done in a straight forward and open manner so the donor understands the purpose of the planned ministry and how their contributions will be used.

Guidelines for Appeal Letters

Appeal letters must be limited to personal friends, family, co-workers or Sunday School class members. Prospective team members who teach Sunday School in Preschool, Children or Student areas may appeal to other teachers in their Sunday School hour. *Mass appeals to those outside a member's direct sphere of relationships are not acceptable and can create extremely negative feelings toward our commitment to Missions Projects*. **Please do not violate this guideline.**

Appeal letters must....

- Be limited to one page and original (no form letters for the entire team).
- Include information about the country, project goals and why the participant feels led to take part in the project.
- Contain the published cost of the trip and how the recipient can be involved (prayer, financial, supplies.)
- Explain that all checks are to be made payable to First Baptist Church; returned to First Baptist Church and received before the deadline set by the Project Coordinator (this is extremely important if you are not financing the project with your own funds.) Contributors may write the project name on the memo line of the check. Gifts to First Baptist are non-refundable.

In the event that I receive financial support which exceeds the amount needed to cover my expenses for the trip, any additional funds will be allocated to helping other team members participate, or toward the general team expenses, such as tracts, Bibles, first aid supplies, etc. In the event that I cannot go on the trip (due to the inability to raise the necessary funds or for some other unforeseen reason), all funds donated on my behalf will go toward the trip for other team members or for general team expenses.
