Premier's Spelling Bee Regional Finals.

On, Thursday 10th September, the Riverina Regional Finals of the Premier's Spelling Challenge took place in Corowa at Corowa Public School. Our representatives in the Year 3/4 section were: Macey White and Lachlan Shepherd. Macey made it through to round 4 before going out and Lachlan made it through to round 5, which put both students in the final ten spellers out of the 32 entered from across the Riverina.

The Year 5/6 final was held today for our students via Video Conference (VC) due to our students attending the Canberra excursion last week. Our representatives Sami-J Campbell and Rose Chamberlain were excited about doing the spelling bee on VC. Sami-J Campbell made it through to round 4 before going out and Rose made it through to round 6 before missing her final word which placed her in the top 6 of the competition. Well done on your wonderful efforts students, great results all round.

It will be held in Barooga in late October due to the abundance and availability of turf wickets which are the preferred wicket for representative level cricket.



The rotating dinner will be an enjoyable social night where you get to mix with different people from our community, eat great food and enjoy a relaxing night out. All proceeds will go towards providing additional resources and opportunities for the Tocumwal Preschool students.

You and your partner will enjoy a three course meal, with each course prepared and eaten at a different host home within Tocumwal. There will be 6 people at each course, and the people you are dining with will change at each venue.

Beginning the evening at Tocumwal Terminus Hotel, each couple will receive their 'Meal Map'. Following a specific timeline, the evening will conclude back at the Terminus for tea/coffee or refreshments.

Each household can choose whether they would like to host an entrée, main or dessert. The cost of the evening will vary depending on which course you choose to host. There is also an option for those residing out of town to participate.

Those providing an entrée \$30pp, main \$20pp and dessert \$35pp.

Those not hosting will need to pay \$70pp. For those preparing a course, keep in mind there will be relatively short time to serve and eat each course before moving on, so we suggest meals or dishes which can be prepped earlier.

Once you have made your selection, you will receive confirmation via formal invitation in the week preceding the event.
