Snowmobile Safety Training

December 19 & 20 the Trail Blazers are hosting Snowmobile Safety Training at the Grand Lake Fire Station. For more information, or to sign up, call **Debbie Mason 970-531-3480** or **Tom Mason 970-531-5812**. The Safety Training is for any rider of any age. Kids aged 10 - 16 can legally ride solo on public lands in Colorado (unless there are local regulations that override this rule, such as in Grand

Lake) if carrying their Safety Certificate. Saturday is the classroom session, from 8:00 to about noon. Participants should bring light snacks to get through the morning. They should also dress warmly – we will go outside to go over the parts of the snowmobile and basic riding positions. We will discuss many aspects of safety, riding, clothing, etc., to prepare riders for what they will encounter out on the trails. Sunday, we meet again at 8:00 to take a written test on the material covered Saturday. After the written test, each student goes to East Inlet to take a practical test of basic riding techniques and safety on a snowmobile. For the Sunday test, participants need to bring a snowmobile, helmet and adequate, warm clothing. Let's hope we get plenty of snow before then – right now it's pretty darned thin.

We will be needing helpers to help Larry Goscha set up and work the driving course on Sunday morning. If you can help, contact Tom or Debbie Mason (970-531-5812 or 3480 or Larry Goscha 970-627-5421). If we have the snow for it, course set-up can be done between 8:30 & 9:00 and the first riders could show up any time starting (probably) around 9 or so.
