NDTA Advanced Pediatric Handling and Problem Solving Course

This NDTA Advanced pediatric course is offered to NDTA Certified therapists and therapists who have successfully completed a NDT/Bobath certificate course titled: Pediatric Management and Treatment of Children with Cerebral Palsy and other Neuromotor Conditions who are seeking opportunities to enhance clinical skills. A review of current concepts in Neuro-Developmental Treatment and motor behavior theories sets the stage for advancing assessment and treatment skills through direct practical application with clients who have neuromotor dysfunction. Daily treatment demonstrations by course instructors will be preceded by videotaped assessments and group discussions regarding clinical reasoning related to functional outcomes, participation, impairments and treatment planning. Participants will assess and treat patients daily and receive consultation and mentoring by the instructors. Group discussions and facilitation labs will assist with application and synthesis of course material.

Objectives

At the completion of this course, the participant should be able to:

1. Identify current concepts of postural control and movement.
2. Analyze factors which interfere with the performance of functional activities.
3. Apply and synthesize information to develop appropriate treatment strategies for persons with neurological dysfunction.
4. Demonstrate ability to implement appropriate treatment strategies designed to improve function during treatment practicum.
