
It is often claimed it is not a 'level playing field' when it comes to securing construction contracts for paving, road and highway work. Contractors undercutting competitors by ignoring health and safety responsibilities is cited as one of the reasons. The poor management of health risks observed in many road and highway construction and maintenance sites is considered a direct result of this. While the evidence is anecdotal it can be envisaged that pressures to win contracts may mean that contractors could identify the money spent on health and safety as a means to cutting costs. The subject is being discussed focusing on the following four potential health risk management issues:

- Why clients do not give occupational health priority in the procurement and tender process
- Monitoring and enforcement of the health aspects of a contract
- Inconsistency between clients
- Relevant health risk management standards for procurement and tender

During this workshop Dr Robert Ellis of the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) will present the proposals and then facilitate a discussion about their likely effectiveness. It is the intention that feedback from these discussions will be included in the HSE's final report.
