For our 2015 Reunion in Washington, DC, we have contracted with the highly-rated Westin Crystal City Hotel in Arlington, VA (4.5 out of 5 star Expedia rating), conveniently located one block from the Metro and close to Reagan International Airport. Because of our flexibility, we were able to negotiate an excellent weekend rate of \$119.00, plus tax, which includes a hot breakfast, free self-parking, and free shuttle service to Reagan Airport. Because their main business is government, the weekdays are their busy days and we could not get our usual guarantee of the same rate for those staying before and after the reunion. Those interested in pre- or post- reunion stays should check with the hotel for the availability of special rates.

We have put together a slate of attractions that will have something for everyone. All are priced on an ala carte basis, so you can participate in as many or as few as you like.

After check-in on Thursday, September 24, the Hospitality Room will open at 2:00 p.m. We will assemble at 5:30 p.m. for the Cocktail Hour and Welcome Aboard deli buffet.

On Friday, September 25, our tour will include some of the most requested sights of

Washington, DC. The tour has been designed to maximize our sight-seeing opportunities while minimizing the amount of walking required. A box lunch will be provided. We will return to the hotel by 5:30 p.m.

On Saturday, September 26, we will have the unique opportunity to see Mount Vernon by Water Cruise. We will enjoy a cruise on the Potomac River to Mount Vernon where we will have lunch on our own and spend the afternoon touring the estate. We will return to the hotel by 5:00 p.m.

On Sunday, September 27, we will hold our Memorial Service at 10:00 a.m., followed by the Business Meeting at 10:30 a.m., concurrent with the complimentary Ladies Coffee, Tea and Gift Exchange. The afternoon is free until the 6:00 p.m. Cocktail
