

Things To Do & Places to Visit in Nashville

- Nashville Shores Water Park
Enjoy exciting water rides at this attraction, and don't miss the zip lines at the Treetop Adventure Park, too.
- Grand Ole Opry
The city's biggest attraction showcases exceptional talent and offers good, old-fashioned fun.
- Opry Mills
Is a shopper's paradise with more than 200 outlet stores, as well as a cinema, an IMAX theater and dining options.
- Country Music Hall of Fame
Dedicated to the legends that formed this popular genre, the Country Music Hall of Fame introduces visitors to the industry's most famous artists.
- Ryman Auditorium
Dating back to the 1880s, the Ryman—formerly home of the Grand Ole Opry—has long been a performing arts staple of Nashville.
- The Hermitage
Tour the beautifully preserved home and gardens of Andrew Jackson, a champion of liberty and the seventh president of the United States.
- Belmont Mansion
This 1850s, Italian-style villa is a historic landmark that is now a part of Belmont University's campus.
- The Parthenon
This full-size replica of the Parthenon and the statue of Athena was built in 1897 for the city's centennial, and it now houses Nashville's art museum.
- Nashville Zoo at Grassmere
The Nashville Zoo at Grassmere features more than just the animals. There's also a train ride, a tour of the Grassmere Historic Home and a jungle gym for children.
- Belle Meade Plantation
Tour this Greek-Revival mansion and other buildings on the property, which include a horse stable, a log cabin and a carriage house.

Shuttle Service to Downtown Nashville

This guided tour of Nashville stops at 17 stops with over 100 points of interest and is led by fun and informative driver/guides. The tour (one complete loop) lasts approximately 1.25 hours. There is an additional 15 minute stop at Nashville's Riverfront Train Station. Or, take advantage of the hop-on/hop-off privileges and make a day (or TWO) of it!

Stops include: The Riverfront Train Station, Walk of Fame Park/Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum, The Johnny Cash Museum, Ryman Auditorium, The Arcade/Avenue of the Arts, Tennessee State Museum, Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum, Bicentennial Mall & Nashville Farmers' Market, Marathon Motors Creative Works featuring Antique Archaeology Mike Wolfe's shop from American Pickers, Green Brier Distillery, The Parthenon at Centennial Park, Spirit of Nashville Design Studio, Vanderbilt University, The Gulch, the Frist Center for the Visual Arts, and the Visitor's Center.
