The Mike Hatcher Race track was started back in 1983 by its founders Jim Pask, Jim Mc Farlane and Bo McFarlane. The track was originally located at the site of the Parkwood Golf Course on Napper Road and had a total of 12 members made up of Juniors and Seniors.

Mike Hatcher was a council lobbyist who obtained the original land for the club where they build a Motor-X Track and a Dirt Track. Soon after this the land was sold to the Bartlett Group of Companies, who then developed the Parkwood Golf Course. In 1985 Ivan Gibbs and Lester Hughers worked with council to obtain land for the current Mike Hatcher Park, which is now situated on Captain Cook Dv Labrador on the beautiful Gold Coast.



Back in 1985 the track consisted of a Dirt Track which wove in and out of the trees. Mike Hatcher's first race day consisted of 12 riders, an esky for a bar and a barbecue instead of a canteen. Council then built the club house and in 1987 the seniors approached council to use the complex. They then built their own club house above the juniors' club house.

The track, on its current site, was built by Gary Issel, Peter Neil, Bo McFarlane and Mike Hatcher. In 1986 the club held its first title event being the Junior Short Track title. In 1987 Hatcher's hosted its first Australia Title and since then it has hosted 6 more in 1989, 1992, 1996, 1999, 2003 and again in 2007. The club was affiliated with the Q.J.M.C.A from 1985 - 1993 and in 1994 was affiliated with M.A.Q which is now the controlling body for our sport.



In 1996 both the junior and senior clubs took part in the total reconstruction of a new track, starting gates, increased spectator viewing areas and a new put area with toilets and a first aid room. The funding for the reconstruction was raised by Tony West and we were also assisted by council and help from members in the labour side of the reconstruction.

This Club has produced some amazing results with many WORLD CHAMPIONS kicking off their career here at the Club, MICK DOOHAN, TROY BAYLISS, JASON CRUMP and even CASEY STONER.

This Club has provided a safe, secure and supervised facility for many young riders in the past and will continue to do so for many years to come.

Signage details

Signage will be 2.4mts x 1200 apart from barrier signage that will be 2.4mtrs x 1mtr as the barriers stand 1mtr high. Signage can be made larger for area's eg Clubhouse at sponsor's costs.

All signage has a 3 yr guarantee to fading and rust they are an Aluminium Composite panel 3mm.

All signage will be produced and fixed by a professional sign company.

All sponsors will have their Company details put in Race programmes also the race caller on the day will broadcast all sponsors details over the PA every Race Day.
