Who do we serve?

Regardless of the medical facility being used we serve the following: 1. Outpatient veterans that must travel to Reno for their medical care. It can be one night to cover

an appointment or 8 weeks of radiation and chemotherapy

2. The family of a hospitalized veteran

3. The veteran if their immediate family member is receiving medical care.

All guests must be able to care for themselves or have a caregiver with them.

Guests are asked to donate \$25/night but no one is turned away for an inability to do so.
