

ANSWERS TO YOUR MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ▶ **How does Every Orphan's Hope work?**
Our orphan-care model pairs four boys and four girls with a widowed woman whom they call "mama." The family lives in a brick home where they are loved and cared for in a Christ-centered environment. Our goal is to match 12 sponsors with a child. This enables sponsors to commit to an affordable monthly investment and it showers the orphans with love!
- ▶ **How does my sponsored child actually benefit from \$31/month?**
A dollar a day goes a long way in Zambia. Your donation is an investment in your child's housing, healthcare, his or her specialized caregivers, three nutritious meals a day, as well as primary and secondary school fees, supplies and uniforms. Also, part of your monthly donation goes toward a mama's stipend. This mama devotes her life to raising your sponsored child as her own.
- ▶ **What is the best way to communicate with my sponsored child?**
The best way is through hand-written letters. To send a letter, please refer to the bottom of this brochure for our address. You can also email your letter to info@everyorphan.org with your child's name in the subject line. Don't forget to connect with your child via Facebook. Each of our homes has its own private Facebook group where you can post a comment to your child and our staff in Zambia will deliver the message.
- ▶ **Can I go visit my sponsored child?**
Yes! We offer short-term mission trips and internships to Zambia every summer. Visit everyorphan.org and click on How To Help/Mission Trips.

▶ Can I send gifts to my child?

Yes! Visit everyorphan.org and click on Resources/Send Gifts for a list of approved gift ideas. Please send your gifts in a (closed) zip lock bag with your child's name on the bag. ▶ What gifts should I send?

A gift list with approved items is available at everyorphan.org. Select Resources/Send Gifts. *Please do not send electronics, breakable items, heavy items, books (small handheld Bibles are fine), stuffed animals or food items.* Also, we ask that you consider sending a gift to the mama who cares for your child. Please mark your package with your child's name.

▶ How often will I receive an update from my child?

Our staff in Zambia sends us updates regarding the progress of your child's education, health needs and prayer requests. As we receive these updates, we will include them on your Facebook group page. You will also receive two letters and/or drawings from your child within a 12-month period.

▶ How do I benefit from sponsoring a child?

Sponsoring a child is like welcoming a new member into your family. A unique relationship is formed between you and your sponsored child that is both spiritually and emotionally rewarding. You can pray for your child's specific needs as you learn his or her prayer requests in your private Facebook group. You will receive hand-written letters and/or drawings from your sponsored child, and you can enjoy videos of your sponsored child at everyorphan.org.
