I hope you were able to spend some time enjoying your children over break!

We are so excited to be back at school. There is much to do! By this point in the year, we have begun to really focus on which interventions are needed in specific areas for certain children. By utilizing the many assessments available to us, we can pinpoint skill areas and progress monitor students to make sure they are making needed growth. Many teachers administer these interventions during a time of the day we call "I and E time." This is a time when there is no new instruction and students receive Interventions or Enrichment as needed. Typically this is 20-30 minutes per day. Sometimes support is provided by an Intervention Specialist for a grade level so students with similar needs can receive intense interventions together. We will also be working very systematically with our third grade students to achieve our goal of having all students meet the rigorous requirements of the Ohio Third Grade Reading Guarantee.

It is absolutely thrilling that we will be able to make some adjustments to programming for next year with the passage of our recent levy! One exciting change is that all elementary students will once again be able to have Art, Music, and Physical Education classes one day a week all year long. As the district considers how to move forward with other programs, they will consider many factors before making final decisions.

# Explanation of How Trebein PTO is Set Up


