2016 THINK LOCAL YOUTH BURSARY

The Lorne Community Development Corp. is pleased to offer the Think Local Youth Bursary to a graduating high school student. This award recognizes a student who demonstrates a clear and committed plan to utilize their acquired post-secondary education to return to the Municipality of Lorne to live, work and contribute to the betterment of the community. Students must reside in the service area of the Lorne CDC to qualify. Award is not based on academic grades or financial need. The bursary will be in the amount of up to \$1,000, with \$500 disbursed at the time the student enrolls in an accredited post-secondary education institution, and \$500 disbursed upon their return to Lorne to live, work or open a business.

Applicants are **required** to provide a completed application form and supporting documents. Supporting documents **must include** a copy of their official high school transcript or a letter verifying that they qualify to graduate in 2016. Supporting documents may also include verification of acceptance to their post-secondary education program and/or institution.

The first half of the award (\$500) is distributed only after the student submits proof of paid enrollment in an accredited post-secondary program or institution by October 30, 2016. Failure to provide such proof by the deadline forfeits the entirety of the award. The second half of the award (\$500) is distributed only after the student has shown satisfactory evidence of having completed their education program and resettled in the Municipality of Lorne to live, work or start a business. Failure to return and resettle in Lorne forfeits the second disbursement (\$500) of the award.
