Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha (1656-1680) faced enormous challenges, beginning with the loss of her parents and brother when she was only four. The smallpox that took their lives left her with marked skin and damaged vision. Although her mother was a Catholic Algonquin, the uncle who adopted her was a Mohawk chief as was her father. Her interest in Christianity blossond when a Jesuit missionary came to her village. Tekakwitha received instruction in the faith and was baptized Kateri (Katherine) in 1676. This courageous decision made her an outcast among her people. For her safety, she was urged to leave the village. She walked 200 miles to a Christian ivllage near Montreal. There she lived the gospel with zeal and ministered to the needs of the people. Kateri was the first Native American to be named blessed. She will be canonized on October 21, and is the patroness of ecology and the

environment. Her feastday is July 14.

ROSE HRABEC

Mrs. Ruzena Hrabcová followed her husband in death just three weeks after his funeral. Both spouses were joined by a strong marital bond that not even death could break. Ruzena married her husband, Joseph, in 1946 in their homeland, Czechoslovakia, and shared with him the "better or worse" of their life together, which meant for both newlyweds to start off on travel to many parts of the world.

In 1948 her husband, Joseph, went to Buenos Aires, Argentina, to establish a Bata subsidiary to sell machinery for rawhides. In 1950 he arranged for her and two daughters to leave Czechoslovakia and to join him in Argentina. Three years later the family moved to Brazil, where he worked in the import-export business until the mid-60s. In 1964 they decided that the US was a more stable country offering more opportunities, so once again he moved his family, settling in Los Angeles.

Joseph and Rose moved to Palmdale in the early 90s but continued to be devoted to their family, coming every week to Woodland Hills to see their grandchildren. Rose was a loving wife to Josef, a devoted mother to Hana and Ludmila. They were married for 66 years. A woman of deep faith, Rose, with her husband, was generous to the Czech Catholic Mission and came to the Czech Mass as often as she could.
