## Featuring Dr. Michael Pikos of the Pikos Implant Institute

*Maxillary Alveolar Ridge Regenerative Strategies:*

*From Extraction Site Management to Full Arch Reconstruction*

The loss of alveolar ridge contour in the maxilla compromises implant reconstruction and creates a myriad of esthetic, functional, prosthetic and surgical challenges for the implant team. This clinical based presentation will feature a CBCT based sequential diagnostic protocol including the latest hard and soft tissue grafting techniques for single tooth to full arch implant reconstruction. The use of autogenous, allograft, and xenograft substrates including resorbable and nonresorbable mesh will be covered. Foundational tissue engineering principles will include the use of PRGF, rhPDGF, and rhBMP-2/ACS. After this presentation attendees will be able to: 1. Understand the importance of a sequential CBCT based digital diagnostic protocol for maxillary alveolar ridge augmentation; 2. Appreciate the indications for maxillary extraction site management and ridge augmentation; 3. Understand the application and protocols of current hard and soft tissue grafting techniques for maxillary alveolar ridge augmentation.

The South Seas Island Resort (formerly South Seas Plantation) is located at the northern end of Captiva Island, just west of Ft. Myers, FL.

There are several accomodation types, ranging from \$169-\$399. These special rates expire May 20, 2013, or when sold out. The resort has waived the standard daily resort fees, and the group rates will be honored three days prior to and following. Call 888-707-7888 and identify yourself as part of the Southern Academy. Before making your reservations, you can access a map of the resort on our website at [www.periosouth.org](http://www.periosouth.org) to select where you want to stay on the property.

Travelling by car, from Interstate 75 exit Daniels Parkway (131) toward Cape Coral/Airport. Turn left onto Six Mile Cypress Pkwy, which becomes Gladiolus Pkwy. Take CR-869 S ramp toward Captiva. Merge onto Summerlin Rd., which becomes McGregor Blvd., which becomes Sanibel Causeway (toll). Follow signs to Captiva and continue to resort entrance at end of road.

By air, Ft. Myers International Airport, about a 50-minute drive from South Seas.

South Seas is a 330-acre, self-contained property with frequent trolleys running the length of the resort. There is a special service available at the airport from Hertz. You can save the cost of renting a car for your entire stay by renting a car at the airport and turning it in upon your arrival at South Seas. You can then re-rent for the return to the airport.
