Message to parents: Equamore Foundation is a tax-exempt charity operating the Equamore Sanctuary and Academy. The Foundation's mission is to give lifelong sanctuary to aged, abused, or neglected horses without alternatives for their care. We also fund education programs designed to make the public aware of the problem of unwanted horses and to teach strategies for solving that problem one horse at a time. We encourage the creation of "horse rescue teams" by individuals with limited funds who join together to support one horse at the Equamore Sanctuary in Ashland, Oregon. Our junior program for minors between the ages of 14 and 18 is designed to connect young people to one special horse about whom they can learn and for whom they can contribute their ideas for making sure that this one horse never again suffers from hunger, neglect, or cruelty. Although teens are free to contribute money to the Foundation, they are not required to do so to become a member of an Equamore Horse Rescue Team.
