SUNDAY 8th May 2016





Welcome to the 2016 SOUTH SUFFOLK CLASSIC, a tour for Classic Cars organised by Eastern Counties Motor Club and West Suffolk Motor Club to raise money for the East Anglian Air Ambulance and sponsored by KERRIDGES of Needham Market.

The route will be approximately 85 miles and will start from North Street Sudbury from 9am. A number of cafeterias will be open for drinks and light refreshments in North Street and your entry includes a voucher for two cups of tea or coffee.

The first section will take you South West to the MoD Police vehicle museum which displays both MoD and civilian police vehicles and equipment. From here you will travel North West to Anglesey Abbey and Lode Mill. This is a National trust property and has an excellent Restaurant. The final leg takes you East to our traditional finish at the South Suffolk Show.

The time schedule will be flexible enough for participants to decide for themselves whether they wish to take their time and enjoy the facilities of the checkpoints or motor on and get to the Show in time for more of the attractions there. A summary of the route and distances will be included in the road book to help with the planning process. A time schedule for the Show will be included with the final instructions.

There are several places of interest which we will be passing and which will be noted in the road book. Rather than have controls at these we have decided to give you the option to choose which if any you would like to look at (or note for the future) and decide your pace accordingly.

The routes have been designed throughout to make minimal use of 'A' roads and we have endeavoured to find some good 'driving' roads too for you to enjoy.

There will be an assembly at the Show as usual. This year the numbers of Classics should be augmented by a static display which will be at the Show all day.

The entry fee this year to £30.00 per car but we invite you to pay a further £2.50 (more if you wish) in the knowledge that all extra will go straight into the East Anglian Air Ambulance fund. A minimum of £2.50 per entry is pledged to go to the Air Ambulance from the basic entry.

Please get your entry in early so we can include you in the South Suffolk Show souvenir programme. To help us with promotion a photograph of your car would be appreciated if it is new to the event.

We will only use it for this event and it will not be passed to anyone else. It would be a great help to us to communicate with you about the SSC.

The final instructions will be sent out during the week before the event.

REGULATIONS

Definitions

- 1. The South Suffolk Classic Car Run 2016 is a Touring Assembly for passenger cars.
- 2. The event, which is not competitive, will take place on SUNDAY 8th MAY 2016.
- 3. The organisers and promoters are the Eastern Counties Motor Club Ltd and West Suffolk Motor Club Ltd.
- 4. The event is organised under a Certificate of Exemption issued by the Motor Sports Association. You do not have to be a club member to enter.
- 5. By applying to enter, all participants undertake to comply with these regulations and any additional instructions issued by the organisers. Such additional instructions will have the same power as these regulations.
- 6. The Clerks of the Course have absolute discretion in the application and amendment of these regulations, breach of which may result in exclusion from the event.
- 7. The route will start at North Street, Sudbury and finish at the South Suffolk Show at Ampton.
- 8. The route will include check points, which will be specified in the route book given to each participant. Check points will only be open between specified times.
- 9. Eligible Vehicles The event is open to all three and four wheeled motorcars manufactured up to 1990. Cars manufactured after this date, heavily modified cars, kit cars, cars of particular interest and light commercial vehicles may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers. Such decision will be based on an assessment of the historical context and interest of individual vehicles. Owners of such vehicles are requested to consult with the organisers prior to submitting their entry. Heavy commercial vehicles, agricultural vehicles and motorcycles are not permitted.
- 10. All vehicles must have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act, a valid MoT Test certificate and be licensed for use on the public road. Trade plates are not permitted. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that the vehicle used is in roadworthy condition.
- 11. The maximum number of starters for the event is 90 and the minimum is 40. If the minimum number is not achieved, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.
- 12. Participants will be provided with numbered identification plates, which must be clearly displayed in a forward facing position near the front of the car. No other numbers may be displayed, other than the vehicle registration number.
- 13. No advertising, trade sign or promotional display may be carried on or distributed from any vehicle without the organisers' consent.
- 14. Eligible Participants and Drivers Entry may be made by any person over 17 years of age who holds a full drivers licence.
- 15. Only drivers named on the entry form may drive on the event.
- 16. Passengers may be carried up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided.
- 17. Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close on Friday 29th April 2016. The minimum entry fee is £30.00. Late entries may be accepted up to 4th May 2015 but these

- will not be included in the Show Programme. Any addition to the entry fee will go straight into the East Anglian Air Ambulance Fund.
- 18. The entry fee includes admission to all venues except that at Anglesey Abbey you will asked to pay a supplement if, in addition, you wish to go into the House. Our arrangement with the National trust recognises that many of our regular participants are Trust members and we would ask you to please show you membership card on entry. The afore-mentioned supplement will not, of course apply to members.
- 19. Entries must be on the official entry form (feel free to copy the forms for a friend), which must be signed by the participant and all persons who may drive, and sent to:

- 20. Cheques must be made payable to Eastern Counties Motor Club Ltd
- 21. Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.
- 22. A request to withdraw from the event must be made in writing (includes email). The entry fee will then be returned less £2 administration charge.

Documentation, Eligibility and Scrutineering

- 23. In the week prior to the event, final instructions including directions to the start will be forwarded to all participants together with details of catering facilities.
- 24. Before starting the event, participants will be required to sign an indemnity and a declaration stating that their vehicle is insured in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act for all persons who will drive the vehicle, has a valid MoT Test Certificate where applicable and that all persons who will drive hold a valid full driving licence for the vehicle to be driven.
- 25. Any vehicle that does not comply with these regulations or is deemed inappropriate for the event will not be allowed to start.
- 26. Start Cars will leave the start at regular intervals with the oldest cars departing from 09.00. Participants must arrive at the start at least 30 minutes before their starting time, to allow enough time to complete any official documentation but we recommend you allow an hour.
- 27. Postponement or Cancellation The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstance arise, which makes this desirable or necessary. In such circumstances the return of entry fees will be at the organiser's discretion.
