2016 NAFOW Tour Descriptions

All Currency listed in CAN\$

1. Thursday, September 1, 2016, Head Smashed in Buffalo Jump and Fort MacLeod

Price: \$75.00, Entrance fees to both sites and boxed lunch are included in the price. Assemble at 8:15 in the hotel lobby, tour will leave at 8:30am, and return between 4:30 and 5:00pm.

Leaving the Westin, Calgary, the bus will travel south along the Deerfoot Trail/Hwy2 south towards the United States, Alberta's neighbouring state being Montana. The tour will pass through ranch land, to the West the foothills, the Rockies and through the outskirts of High River, a town devastated in 2013 by the same floods that wreaked havoc and millions of dollars of damage in places such as Canmore and Calgary. This 2-hour journey to **Head Smashed-In Buffalo Jump**, will offer a variety of on-bus 'Welsh' entertainment which will keep you smiling and comfortable.

Head Smashed in Buffalo Jump is located in the foothills where the Rockies meet the Great Plains, [headsmashedin.org]. In 1981, UNESCO designated this as a World Heritage Site, a site that preserves the remarkable history of the Plains First Nations peoples and bears witness to their hunting practices of over nearly 6,000 years. This wonderful interpretive centre will take you through the millennia introduced by a short movie in the theatre. The exhibits are on several levels and there are elevators for those who wish to use them. All tours are guided by a member of the Blackfoot tribe. After the tours the group will be picked by the bus to proceed on a short trip to lunch at Fort MacLeod.

Fort MacLeod was established in 1874, and became the headquarters of the North-West Mounted Police, the forerunners of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. Their main task in the early years was containing the whisky trade and enforcing agreements and maintaining relations with the First Nations people. At Fort MacLeod the group will enjoy a boxed lunch and beverages [no whisky]. After lunch, a movie of the fascinating history of the North West Mounted Police will be shown and a tour taken of the museum and the 1874 fort buildings. The return trip to Calgary will, once again, be a fun journey with many 'bus door prizes', a quiz on the day's tours, and other entertainment including time for chatting, and '40 winks' for those who wish.

2. Monday, September 5-7, 2016, Banff Canadian Rockies Excursion

Prices vary depending on package selected. Assemble at 8:00am in the hotel lobby, excursion leaves at 8:30am

Why not stay longer and take in what Alberta has to offer? Extend your stay by adding 2 nights in Banff * in the Canadian Rockies at the Mount Royal Hotel. **Extend your 2-day Banff stay for up to an additional three nights. Organized group activities are only included on first two days. See page 5 for prices on all package options.*

The tour leaves the Westin Calgary on Monday, Sept. 5, 2016. You will have a full day of touring en route to Banff, visiting the spectacular scenery of Lake Louise and surrounding areas. Stay at the Mount Royal Hotel, located in downtown Banff, with shops, restaurants and more just on your doorstep. On Tuesday, take a half-day tour which will include a ride on the Banff Gondola, for a panoramic 360 degree view of the surrounding areas, followed by a 1 hour cruise on Lake Minnewanka, Banff's largest glacial lake, lunch included. There will be a group dinner on Tuesday evening.

The 2 night package includes: Transportation from Calgary; 2 nights at the Mt. Royal Hotel; tours and admissions for a full day Monday and half day Tuesday; lunch is included both days and group dinner on Tuesday evening. Prices listed are per person, based on double occupancy, if you do not wish to share a room, select the single occupancy room rate.

You will receive a 20% discount rate on shuttle to Calgary Airport which departs from the Banff Mount Royal Hotel 5 times a day.
