Bringing Change From the Inside

HMPs Ashfield & Bristol – We will be finishing our current Christianity Explored (CE) courses at these two prisons in the first week of November and have had three/four men consistently coming to both who have been a real joy and encouragement with their questions and engagement. Please pray for true heart change and salvation, particularly for two guys, S and J who seem to be really searching. Also pray for our next courses – CE at HMP Bristol and Discipleship Explored (DE) at HMP Ashfield. (Run by David, Lindsay & others)

HMP Cardiff – The CE in a week course was blessed by the Lord. Please pray in particular for A who knows the Gospel but is struggling with the 'riches of this world'. Please also pray for R who said that he wanted Jesus in his life, but when we asked him about this he was unsure of what he really meant. Pray that he would have a real encounter with our Saviour. HMP Eastwood Park – Please pray that enough women would sign up to make another course possible before Christmas. (Lindsay & Gillian)

HMP Featherstone – Please pray for the DE course starting next week led by Nigel.

HMP Oakwood – Please pray for several members of the Oakwood group who have been released or moved to other prisons that they may go on and grow in faith.

Pray especially for James who has been involved with Daylight for several years at two different prisons. He has been given parole but he is very vulnerable due to abuse suffered during his childhood and will need lots of support at the hostel he has been allocated. (Nigel)

HMP Portland— Give thanks that Matthew, a Daylight PMA has a new opportunity to run Bible Studies in this prison starting on the 17th November. Please pray for good attendance and that the prisoners would be willing to learn from the Bible.

HMP Swansea – We have completed the CE course, finishing with three prisoners. We are now continuing with this group running DE. Please pray for the course and that we will have the approval to run a weekly Bible study following on from DE. (David, Stephen & Jane)
