Lyman's Athletic Booster Club will be awarding one \$1000 scholarships to deserving Lyman students for the 2015-2016 school year*. The scholarships are open to students who meet all eligibility requirements.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Must be a "senior".
- 2. Minimum GPA of 3.0
- 3. Be in "good standing with Lyman High School.
- 4. Student or parent must be a four year booster member with no break in years.
- 5. Present a letter of recommendation from their coach/teacher, a scholarship application, and a completed essay (see below for essay criteria) by **March 9, 2016** to Mrs. Hoeflich

Essay Question and Criteria:

How will this scholarship help you with college?

To qualify for consideration, your essay must include the following:

- 1. 250-500 words, typed, double-spaced.
- 2. Correct spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
- 3. A clearly thought out response that completely answers the question.

Scholarship funds can be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses.

Student athletes with winning essays must meet the following requirement for distribution of funds:

Proof of acceptance and entry into a post-secondary institution.

*Lyman High School Booster Club reserves the right to award all or none of the scholarships if submitted essays do not meet ALL eligibility requirements and essay criteria as listed above.
