CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The competition is open to all young people who were born from 1 January 1978 on.
- 2. Candidates are requested to pay an entry fee of 20.—euros and fill in the registration form either in Italian or English.
- 3. Artists are allowed to submit only one work that can be flat, three-dimensional, or video, recently produced, and reflecting the competition theme: The double suggestive cultural complexity between the imaginary and reality
- **4.** A first selection of the works will be made by a jury of three professionals who will go through the portfolios submitted not later than **31 December 2013** (the postal stamp will be considered proof). The jurors will choose the works that will enter the competition, and be exhibited within **30 May 2014**. Their decisions will not be open to dispute. The documentation submitted will not be returned, including that of the discarded works, and will become part of Le Arti Tessili Association's files.
- 5. The results of the first selection will be made known by 15 February 2014. The selected artists will be asked to send their work within 30 March 2014. The works must be provided with a hanging device along with the indication of how they must be hanged or shown.
- **6.** Within **30** April **2014** a second jury of 5 textile experts will assign the prizes after inspecting the works submitted in due time. Their decisions will not be open to dispute. The prize-granting ceremony will be held during the inauguration of the exhibition. The winners will be informed accordingly.
- **7.** The names of the jury members will be made known in www.leartitessil.it, in the press releases, and during the prize-granting ceremony.
- **8.** A catalogue will be published showing both the selected and prized oeuvres. Each artist will receive three copies of the catalogue. The catalogues can be collected during the exhibition or will be shipped back along with the work at the end of the event.
- **9.** All transportation expenses (to and fro) will have to be borne by the artists including possible customs duties. Should the shipment of the oeuvre involve extra expenses or fees, the artist will have to reimburse them.
- **10.** The works will be returned upon the exhibition completion. The artists who will not collect their work personally or through a forwarding agent of their choice, can ask the Association to contact a local forwarding agent on their behalf. If the selected artists decide to possibly donate their work to the Association, their piece will become part of the *Valcellina Collection*.
- 11. Information will be sent to the artists via e-mail in Italian and English with confirmation of receipt.
- **12.** The Award organizers will be responsible for the mounting of the exhibition, and decide about the space to assign to each work.
- **13.** The Association takes no responsibility with regard to any damage or loss of portfolios or works during their forwarding.
- **14.** The selected artists agree that their personal data and pictures be published according to Italian L. D. No. 196/2003 in catalogues, the press, records office or any official initiative which may publicize the Award.
