

41st Anniversary Scholarship Invitational Basketball Tournament

2016 Tigers Youth Club Lillian Kawana and Hank Quock Scholarships

In 2016, the *Tigers Youth Club* will award two special at-large \$600.00 scholarships to the top graduating high school senior applicants outside of its Club membership. The purpose of these two scholarships is to provide financial assistance to further the education of two Tiger Tournament participants in college, junior college, and/or trade school.

These scholarships are named in honor of **Lillian Kawana** and **Hank Quock**, two current and long-time Tiger members. They each have over 40 years of service to the club. The *Tigers Youth Club* would like to honor them with scholarships offered to applicants outside of its club membership. Applicants should be dedicated students, active in school and in their community, as well as participants in the **2016** *Tigers Youth Club* Basketball Tournament.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The applicant will graduate from high school in May/June 2016.
- 2. The applicant will have an overall minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 based upon the unweighted final grades received in the 10th grade, 11th grade, and the first semester grades of the 12th grade senior year.
 - Applicant will provide an **official** high school transcript as verification of grades received.
 - The GPA is based on the 4.0 numbering system. An average of all letter grades (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0), excluding physical education grades, will be used to calculate the GPA.
 - Plus (+) and minus (-) grades are not recognized in this system and shall be omitted from the letter grade when determining the overall GPA.
 - Special credit or extra points towards the GPA will not be awarded to students taking Advanced Placement courses or any other classes for college credit.
- 3. The applicant will have demonstrated commitment to community service.
- 4. The applicant must write a brief essay (500 words or less) and complete the entire application form.
- 5. The applicant must send in an **original** color photo (high school graduation photo preferred). Photos submitted must be high quality since it will be used for publication in the Tigers Tournament book. **Proofs** will not be accepted. This photo will be returned.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

A completed application must **be postmarked by March 8, 2016**. Applications received after March 8, 2016 will **not** be considered--**NO** exceptions! The *Tigers Youth Club* will not be held liable or responsible for applications lost or delayed in the mail or with insufficient postage.
