Important information for the applicant:

You are applying for a volunteer or staff position, which is directly responsible for the care, supervision, or treatment of children or vulnerable adults.

As provided by state law (RCW 43.43), a disclosure statement must be made by an applicant and background inquiries may be made, of certain civil adjudication's, conviction records of crimes against persons and disciplinary boards final decisions prior to appointment to positions that are directly responsible for the care, supervisor, or treatment of children or vulnerable adults. Such inquiries may be made to state and/or federal law enforcement agencies. Information obtained for the disclosure statement, or from the background inquiries will not necessarily preclude appointment but will be considered in determining the applicant's character, suitability, and competence to perform in the position applied for and may result in denial of appointment. Use of the record of these inquiries will be restricted to the decision on your application.

If you wish to be considered for a volunteer or staff position, you must complete and sign this Applicant Disclosure and Authorization for Background Inquiry form. Failure to complete and sign this form shall disqualify you for appointment in this position. A background check of civil adjudication, conviction records of crimes against persons, and final board disciplinary decisions may be conducted.

If a background inquiry is made to state or federal law agencies, a copy of that response will be made available to you upon request.
