REQUIREMENTS:

- You will need to <u>attend all rehearsals</u> (B-Days for Adv. Jazz or A Days for Int. Jazz). Rehearsals begin at 6:45 AM (Advanced) and 7:05 AM (Intermediate). This is mandatory since it's a class that receives academic credit.
- You will need to <u>attend all performances</u>. The Jazz Ensembles (mainly Adv. Jazz) are sometimes involved in performing for community and school events--some occurring outside of school and on a few weekends. *Please do not audition for this class unless you are committed* to being there.
- 3. Students need to be a member of a MRJH concert band or percussion class. (Some rare exceptions may be made with the director's approval (mainly rhythm section players), however preference is usually given to those in a concert band or percussion class).
- 4. You need to demonstrate good rehearsal skills in band--we will cover a lot of music in this class in only two or three rehearsals a week. Good, productive rehearsals are a must if these bands are to succeed.
- 5. You will need to demonstrate proficiency on your instrument by:
 - Performing the audition music provided.
 - Improvisation is optional (practice with the Bb Blues Progression MP3 file found on the band website on the Jazz Auditions page under student resources).
 - You will be evaluated on correct notes, rhythm, time, tone, articulation and expression.

Advanced Jazz Ensemble meets every B Day from 6:45-8:05 AM. Intermediate Jazz Ensemble meets every A Day from 7:05-8:05 AM. Attendance at rehearsals, sectionals and performances is the main component of your grade with occasional music pass-offs and/or other assignments. Membership in the ensembles may be forfeited if early morning attendance, punctuality, or missed performances proves to be a problem. Adv. Jazz Band will have the same concert attire as Symphonic Band. Int. Jazz will have the same concert attire as Concert Band. There is also a \$30 class fee to help pay for festival, travel, clinicians, sectionals and supply costs.

Materials: Jazz Ensemble members may be required to have their own Jazz Method Book (TBA). Jazz Saxophone players will need their own Jazz Mouthpiece or they may rent them from the school for a nominal fee (\$10.00 for the school year).
