On CREATION DAY NUMBER ONE God created the **earth**, **space**, **time**, and **light verses three** through **five**

verse twenty, "Then God said, 'Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens,"

verse twenty-one, "So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

verse twenty-two, "And God blessed them, saying, 'Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth."

verse twenty-three, "So the evening and the morning were the fifth day."

On CREATION DAY NUMBER SIX God created, and,
verse twenty-four, "Then God said, 'Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle (cattle are representative of four footed animals) and creeping thing (that includes insects) and beast of the earth (that includes vicious carnivorous animals), each according to its kind'; and it was so." verse twenty-five, "And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth, according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."
Definition : evolution is change inside a species Definition : evolution is change from one species to another species
verse twenty-six, "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."
Please notice God introduced Himself with personal plural pronouns: underline three words.
"Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness". This is the first recorded biblical reference to the triune Godhead; that this one being called God exists in three co-equal persons: a Father, a Son and a Holy Spirit. This statement is an unmistakable reference to multiple persons in the Godhead because the name of God that is used in the first 25 verses of Genesis chapter one is a plural name
In Genesis chapter one the original Hebrew word that is translated as God is the plural noun If a Hebrew word has an <i>im</i> ending on it then it's a plural word. God's plural name is indicative that God Himself exists in a plural form. He has a plural nature. He is a Father, Son and Holy Spirit. That is called the trinity and that's developed more in the New Testament.

verse twenty-seven, "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." verse twenty-eight, "Then God blessed them (the male and female) and God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

verse twenty-nine, "And God said, 'See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food.""

verse thirty, "'Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which there is life, I have given every green herb for food'; and it was so."

verse thirty-one, "Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day."
