Junior (J), classes open to riders through the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Young Rider (Y), classes are open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year they turn 16 years of age through the end of the calendar year they turn age 21. Adult Amateur (A), classes are open to non professional riders over the age of 21 who hold a current USEF Amateur card. Qualifying (Q), any class designated for qualifying for the 2015 Great American/USDF Regional Championship.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Entry Procedures: This is one show for two days. Submit one entry blank only! USEF rules and USDF guidelines are in effect from the time horses arrive on the show grounds on show days. Entries will be accepted on a first come basis based on the postmark. No entries postmarked prior to the opening date will be accepted unless the show does not fill. No entries will be accepted without payment in full included. Checks should be made payable to Millbrook Farms. Mail completed entry form to Jan Lawrence, PO Box 237, Cedar Fort, UT 84013. Completed entry forms will include copies of current memberships for USEF, USDF, RMDS and UDS for owner/rider/trainer and coach if applicable, as well as horse registration information for USEF, USDF and RMDS. Please use www.eqverification.org to print off all USEF/USDF cards on one page. Adult Amateurs must include USEF Amateur Card or they will be entered into the Open division. Juniors and Young Riders must include their birthday on their entry blank or they will be entered into the Open division. Freestyle entries must be accompanied by a photocopy of a test verifying eligibility to enter the class (60% score at highest test of level) with the exception of FEI YR and Junior freestyles. All entry forms must have <u>original</u> signatures (rider, owner/agent, trainer, and coach if applicable). A parent or guardian must sign for any Junior under the age of 18. A current Coggins test is required for horses coming from outside the state of Utah. Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses entered by an owner and/or the number of horses ridden by a rider.

Riders who wish to enter Great American/USDF Qualifying Classes, it is your responsibility to have the correct memberships and horse registrations. For more information on which memberships and registrations are required, please go to the USDF website <u>www.usdf.org</u> and look under the Competitions tab.

A returned check will void the entry and incur a \$50 charge. Any entry postmarked after the Closing Date of June 5, 2015 will incur a \$20 post entry fee. Any changes to an entry must be written or emailed to the Jan Lawrence (<u>millbrk@xmission.com</u>) by July 1, 2015. Each change will cost \$10. Change of horse or rider will cost \$25 and will constitute a new entry. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. You must have permission from the Show Secretary before bringing any non-showing horses on the grounds during the competition.

No Shows: We reserve the right to fill all of a competitor's subsequent ride times if a competitor fails to notify the competition of his/her intention to scratch.

Refunds: Refunds less the office fee will be given from the opening date to the closing date. No refunds of any kind for any reason including Acts of God will be given after the closing date and throughout the competition unless rides are filled from the waitlist. The waitlist will be maintained through July 1st. Stabling will be refunded if the horse is scratched on or before July 1st or if the stall can be given to another competitor during the show.

Opportunity Classes: Riders who wish to participate in a recognized show but who do not wish to participate in USEF or USDF award programs may enter the designated Opportunity Classes. These entries must pay all other show related fees (office fee, grounds or stabling fee, etc), but the opportunity classes do not require USEF/USDF memberships or nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Horses may be cross entered into recognized classes with another rider as long as all appropriate fees are paid and/or proof of membership and registrations are provided. All other USEF rules regarding saddlery, attire and conduct of competitors will be in force for the Opportunity Classes.

Awards: Ribbons for First through Sixth place. Tests and ribbons can be picked up at the show office. High point awards will be given by Millbrook Farms for Training through FEI. High point awards are personalized and will be mailed after the competition. There will be no formal awards ceremonies held. High point awards will be given for each of the Musical Freestyle Classes. One award for the combined Classes 117/217, one for Classes 118/218, one for Classes 119/219 and one for the combined Classes 120/220 and 128/228 (all FEI Freestyles combined). In addition, Jim and Donnette Hicks and Sage Creek Equestrian are sponsoring a \$100 cash prize to the highest scoring horse and rider each day of the show in regular dressage classes (Sat Classes 101-116 and 127. Sun Classes 201-216 and 227).

Fees: Class fees for Introduction through Fourth Level, including Opportunity Classes are \$45 per class. FEI and Musical Freestyle Classes are \$55 per class. Great American/USDF Qualifying Classes are an additional \$10 per class. Since this is one show, only one qualifying score per level can be earned. Office fee is \$40 with \$10 refunded for complete entry including copies of all USEF/USDF cards and horse registration. USEF non member fee \$30. USDF non member fee \$25. USEF non member fees apply for <u>each</u> non member (rider, owner/agent, trainer and coach if applicable.) USDF non member fees apply to rider and owner only. USEF Drug Fee mandatory per horse \$16. Grounds fee if not stabled on site \$15 <u>per day</u>. Stabling cost is \$100 for Thursday through Sunday with bedding provided (see below for further information regarding stabling). Times and Acknowledgement: The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. Official times will be posted at noon the day before the show at the Show Office. Unofficial times will be available at <u>www.millbrookfarms.com</u> by July 6, 2015 or you may call the Show Secretary Jan Lawrence at (801)631-2516.

Stabling: <u>Stabling is first-come, first-served with a complete paid entry.</u> Stalls are all permanent, of substantial construction, at least 12' x 12', with solid sides and doors, and are both indoors and newly added under cover outside. Outside paddocks with gates are available that may or may not have shelters. Bedding for all stalls will be provided and is included in the cost. Tack stalls may be available, check with show management. No nails or staples are allowed to be affixed to any stalls. Zip ties are allowed. Hanging organizers are allowed as long as they are not nailed or stapled to the stall itself. All horse riders/owners must provide emergency contact information for horses stabled on site. We will make every effort to accommodate requests for stabling. Contact the Show Secretary Jan Lawrence via phone or email to discuss availability. Stalls are available Thursday, July 9th through Monday, July 13th. (Approximately 50 stalls available on site, not including paddocks.)

Arenas: Two permanent 20m x 60m outdoor arenas with permanent judges' booths. One outdoor 70m x 70m warm up area and one 30m x 70m indoor arena warm up area. All arenas have excellent sand footing. For longing area, inquire at show office or warm up ring stewards. No longing in the warm up areas including the indoor arena. Grooms, trainers, coaches and friends must stay outside of the warm up arenas. Spectator areas are clearly marked and we ask that friends and family accompanying riders be informed to use those areas. Riders and horses always have the right of way during competitions. Schooling during off times and hand walking during the competition must be pre-arranged with show management.

Accommodations/Hospitality: The nearest hotels are 30 minutes away. Days Inn Lehi (801)768-8322, Super 8 Motel Lehi (801)766-8800, Best Western Timpanogos Inn Lehi, (801)768-1400, Hampton Inn Thanksgiving Point Lehi (801)766-1186, and Springhill Suites Thanksgiving Point Lehi (801)341-6970. Both fast food and dine in restaurants are within walking distance of all hotels listed here. Food will also be available on site during the show. Camping on site in self contained units is allowed. Food will be available for purchase during show hours. We have limited RV hookups for \$25/night.

Directions: We are about a mile east of SR-73 in Fairfield. The barn address is 17471 W 1300 N, Fairfield, UT 84013. Directions are available at www.millbrookfarms.com under the directions tab. Please do not rely on Google maps or other GPS directions at this time.

Miscellaneous: This is a private facility. No dogs are allowed on the grounds. Emergency numbers for vet and farrier on call are posted in the show office and near all show stabling areas. An EMT will be on site during the competition and one hour prior to the first ride. Freestyle music must be on an MP3 player or iPod/iPad/iPhone and must be presented to the show announcer. A sound check will be scheduled at the convenience of show management and competitors. Sharps containers are available and their locations will be provided at check in. <u>There is no smoking allowed anywhere on the grounds.</u>
