Fees and Payment

A \$25 per family, non-refundable registration fee is due at the beginning of the school year (August) or whenever the student registers for lessons with the Academy. Students are registering for a 10-month commitment (August – May). Individual course fees are listed in the Course Guide.

Payments for lessons are made on a monthly basis and are due by the 10th of each month. Monthly tuitions vary, depending on the instructor, and the number of lessons given each month.

Payments may be made on-line at LTUMC.ORG, by check, or you can arrange for payments through your personal on-line banking to LTUMC MAA. No cash accepted.

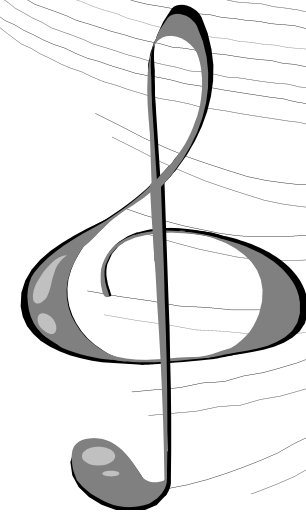

Lesson Schedule

Lessons are scheduled during the school year (August through May), with breaks for holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas, spring break). Students are expected to pay for and attend weekly lessons.

Summer Lessons: If students wish to study during the summer months, instructors will schedule lessons on a flexible schedule, based on student and instructor availability, and students will be charged for only those scheduled lessons.

Absentee Policy

Piano (Lee) and Guitar students: call your instructor at least 24 hours in advance if you need to miss a lesson. By calling your instructor at least 24 hours in advance, you will have the opportunity to schedule a make-up lesson. A maximum of two make-up lessons are allowed per term. If you choose not to schedule a make-up lesson, payment is still due for the missed lesson.

Piano (Perin) students: adhere to the "Piano Absentee Policy", as determined by the piano instructor.

Withdrawal Policy

Students wishing to withdraw from the Academy prior to May will need to give a 30-day written notice to the Music Arts Academy administrator, Patty Highland. Payment for lessons during that 30-day period will be expected. Student's registration fee will not be refunded. Non-attendance is not considered to be an official withdrawal and tuition will still be due.
