

**QUALIFICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS  
UNICO FOUNDATION, INC.  
UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

UNICO FOUNDATION, INC. will grant four \$6,000 scholarships to students attending an accredited college or university, each at \$1,500 per school year up to a maximum of 4 years.

**1. MAJOR DON S. GENTILE SCHOLARSHIP**

**STANDARDS FOR CONSIDERATION**

**2. WILLIAM C. DAVINI SCHOLARSHIP**

**ELIGIBILITY**

**A. Italian Origin** – The candidate shall be of Italian origin, i.e. must have one parent or grandparent of Italian origin. Documented and notarized proof may be requested by the selection committee if necessary.

**B. Chapter Recommendation** – A candidate must be recommended by a UNICO Chapter in good standing.

**C. Educational Requirements** – A candidate must be a senior at any public or private secondary school. The applicant must submit either the SAT or ACT test scores and must be recommendable to an accredited college or university by his/her secondary school. The candidate must have a grade point average of at least 3.0 or B.

**D. Financial Need** – Financial need will be considered. In assessing need, the numbers, ages and schooling requirements of brothers and sisters will be taken into account.

**E. Extra-Curricular and Community Participation** – The extent to which a candidate has contributed to the life and welfare of school and/or community will be taken into account in the assessment of merit.

**F. Family members of UNICANS** may apply through their respective chapters.

**G.** Each chapter of UNICO National, in good standing, may submit applicants for each of the UNICO Foundation Scholarships.

**H.** The candidate must pursue his/her course of college study within the year of the scholarship grant. Any deviation will result in forfeiture.

**3. ALPHONSE A. MIELE SCHOLARSHIP**

**ELIGIBILITY:**

To anyone regardless of race, creed or national origin and including above paragraphs B-G inclusive.

**4. THEODORE MAZZA SCHOLARSHIP**

**ELIGIBILITY:**

To anyone regardless of race, creed or national origin and including above paragraphs B-G inclusive. Must major at an accredited college or university in one of the Fine Arts (Architecture, History of Art, Music, Studio Art, Theatre Art).

An application for UNICO Scholarship will be judged by criteria, which, in addition to those listed above for various awards, include scholarship, citizenship and leadership. Evidence of character and personality is sought and will be reviewed with care.

Experience has shown that the interests of the applicants are advanced and the time of the committee is conserved by orderly, concise and chronological presentation on paper sized 8 ½ x 11. Remove all letters from envelopes and bind the letters flat.

Exhibits evidencing notable achievements in leadership, literature, athletics, dramatics, community service or other activities may be attached. The applicant should avoid submitting repetitious accounts.

**MANDATORY INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS THAT MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION**

**APPLICATIONS THAT DO NOT CONFORM TO THE FOLLOWING WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

1. A formal letter of endorsement and presentation signed by the President and/or Scholarship Chairperson of the chapter sponsoring the applicant. (This letter should attest to the data submitted).
2. Two letters of recommendation, neither over 200 words
  - a) one from school official
  - b) one from a member of the community, other than a second school official.
3. A transcript which shows the most recent rank in class and the scores obtained on a national test: either the College Entrance Examination Board Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Testing Program (ACT).

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO SCHOLARSHIP GRANT**

UNICO FOUNDATION, INC. through this program, seeks students of outstanding merit who show an appreciation in the value of an education and who are willing to achieve success. It is to be noted further that along with the maintenance of the required college scholastic standards as a condition precedent in awarding the scholarship, the National Director of Scholarships and UNICO Foundation Trustees reserve unto themselves the right to cancel or otherwise terminate a grant at any time an awardee, in their opinion, directly or indirectly engages in undesirable activities. The National Director of Scholarships and UNICO Foundation Trustees need not assign any reason for their action and the awardee shall have no recourse.

**FILING OF APPLICATIONS**

The application must be signed by a school official and properly certified by the sponsoring chapter President or Scholarship chairperson. One (1) copy **MUST BE** submitted for **EACH** scholarship applied for.

**NOTE:** Recipients will be requested to submit photos upon notification.
