BLUE CROSS OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR DEPENDENTS

Open enrollment for dependents who missed the 31-day enrollment deadline will be held the entire month of September 2006. Employees may enroll dependents in the Blue Cross Medical Plan and Delta/Pacific Union Dental Plan during this time.

Enrollment forms are available in Health Benefits (located at the Education Center). To enroll dependents, please submit to Health Benefits by September 29, 2006 at 4:30 p.m. the completed enrollment forms and appropriate document to prove eligibility:

For Spouse – Certificate of marriage.

For Domestic Partner – Declaration of Domestic Partnership as filed with California Secretary of State.

For Child – Birth certificate, certificate of adoption, or other proof of relationship acceptable to the District.

Grandchildren, nephews and nieces are not considered dependents unless the employee has been appointed the legal guardian of the child. In such case a copy of the document showing legal guardianship is also required.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

After the open enrollment period of September 1st through 29th the normal enrollment timelines will apply. Applications not filed within those time limits will not be accepted until the next open enrollment period during the following September. Please see your description plan for complete information on eligibility and new enrollment to make note of the following:

- Employees anticipating a marriage, birth, adoption or other change in dependent status or needs should check on timelines and document requirements in advance. Following initial enrollment an employee may add new dependents by filing an enrollment form and proof of eligibility in Health Benefits within the following timelines:
 1. A new spouse within 31 days after the date of marriage.
 2. A new domestic partner within 31 days after filing of Declaration of Domestic Partnership.
 3. **A child within 31 days after the birth or the placement of guardianship.**
- Employees and/or dependents who enroll when first eligible will not have any limitation for pre-existing conditions; however, if an employee and/or dependent is not enrolled when first eligible, he/she must wait for Open Enrollment and will have a six month waiting period for pre-existing conditions.

We encourage employees to familiarize themselves with their District health plans by reading plan descriptions provided during orientation and the insurance information available on our website. Plan description booklets and quick reference guides are also available in the Personnel Services office. The annual open enrollment period for employees who would like to change from Delta Dental Plan to the Pacific Union Dental Plan, or vice versa, is the month of **September**.

If an eligible person does not utilize the program, during the calendar year the portion Delta will reimburse for services during the succeeding calendar year shall remain the same.

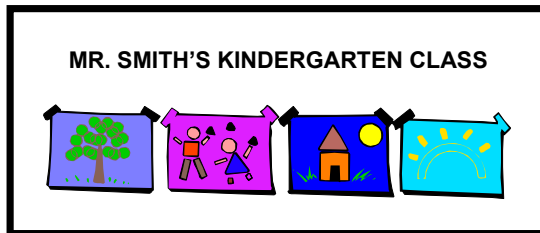

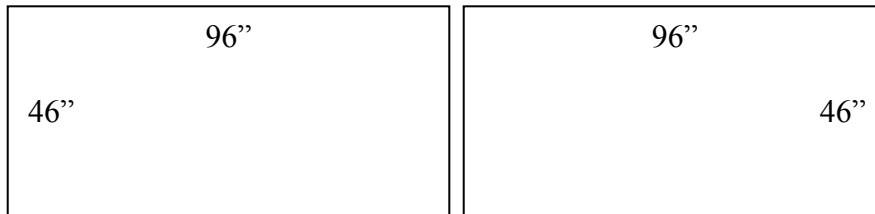

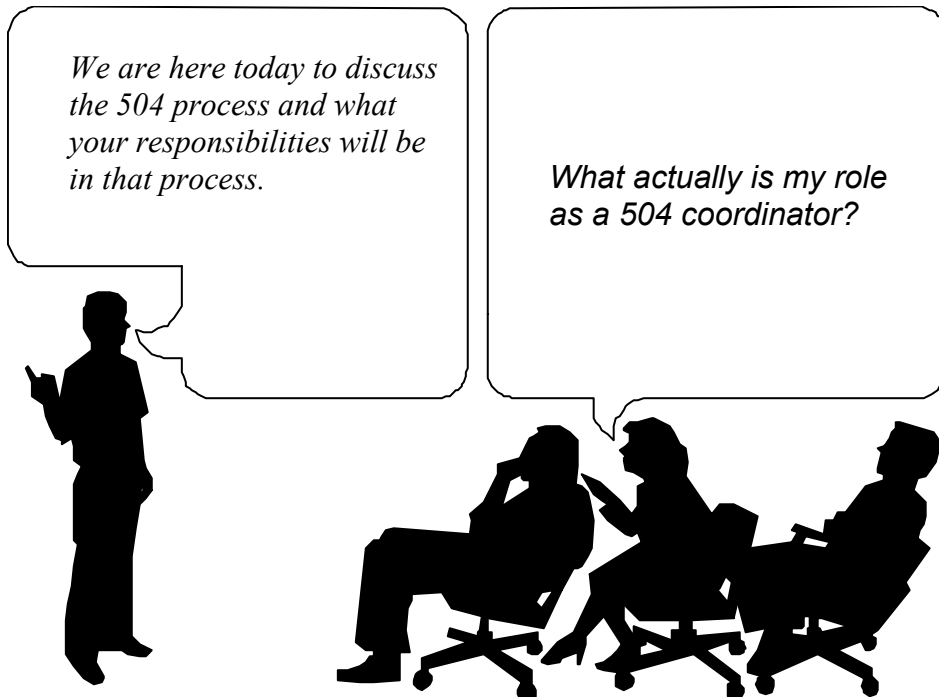
