- 1. Core test scores Students must score 95% in English and 92% in science.
- 2. Essay Each student applying for honors classes will need to write a one page essay for each of the classes they would like to take. The essay will be on the following topics;
 - i. English Discuss how literacy has been and will continue to be an influence in your life.
 - ii. Science What can you learn from doing an extensive science fair project?
 - iii. History Why is it important to study America's past?
- 3. Grades students must have earned an "A" or receive a teachers recommendation in the subject they are applying for.

Expectations:

As an honor student, you will be exposed to a more rigorous and enriched curriculum. Honors students are expected to demonstrate the following characteristics:

- 1. Have a good work ethic. This means always doing your very best work on all assignments and turning in all assignments on time.
- 2. You are expected to participate meaningfully in class discussions.
- 3. You are expected to treat other students with respect and kindness inside and outside of class.
- 4. You are expected to maintain a "B" grade or higher.
- 5. You are expected to earn honors or satisfactory citizenship.
