Principal mahoneys@sps.springfield.ma.us	Founded in 2006, the Springfield Renaissance School provides an interdisciplinary, thematic curriculum within a small school setting that allows students and staff to know each other well. Teaching and learning at Renaissance embraces heterogeneous grouping, differentiated instruction, student-led family conferences, small group learning, and time for remedial support within classes and throughout the middle and high school programs. Literacy instruction is a focus for academic areas, and regular formative assessments provide students, families and teachers with the data and feedback required for successful teaching and learning. The school's Crew course is a key component to its student support program. Flexible scheduling and team planning throughout the middle and high school academic programs allow for frequent teacher collaboration and coordination between disciplines. Advanced Placement and honors courses are offered in 11th and 12th grades. The school has many school programs, hosted by school staff and partner agencies. Some of those programs include: *Over 30 Clubs and Activities like Model UN, Martial Arts, Ladies of Elegance, Yearbook & National Honor Society. *Athletic Teams soccer, golf, hockey, football, girls basketball, tennis and track. Because it is a middle-high school, 7th & 8th graders can participate on the following high school teams: cross-country, volleyball, swimming, boys basketball, and softball.
