THE NATIONAL EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY LAW

To All Riders, Drivers, Students and Guests:

The State of Arizona in 1994 passed the Equine Activity Liability Law through a legislative act designed to limit frivolous and unnecessary lawsuits and for the protection of the Horse Businesses in the State of Arizona.

This law recognizes the fact that horses are unpredictable and cannot be controlled all the time.

An equine professional or an Equestrian Center is not liable for injury or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to RCW 4.24.530

Participants accept responsibility for their own riding level and they are responsible for their own performance on and around the horse.
