DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR WALANT HAND SURGERY

Diet: Re	sume usual diet.	
Medication	Resume your regular medications as prescribed. Take your pain medication as prescribed.	
Activity:	Elevate your hand above your heart level for a minimum of 48 hours. Minimum activity with operated hand arm. Perform gentle digital range of motion exercises (open and close fingers)	
Dressing:	☐ Splint: Do not get wet or disturb in any way. Leave in place till next appt. ☐ Ace wrap: Do not get wet or disturb in any way. *Remove in 72 hours. ☐ Waterproof dressing: Okay to get wet, pat dry, no soaking. *Remove in 72	2 hrs.
	*Following removal of dressing, it is okay to get incision wet, pat dry, no soa Apply Band-Aid to incision, change daily. Do not remove steri-stips! These holding your incision together.
