Entry Criteria

1.Dolls are encouraged to be OOAK, (One of A Kind). If made from a pattern, credit must be given to the designer. The doll must incorporate cloth into its construction.

2. OPTIONAL:

Natural Elements Challenge: Dyeing fabric with walnuts or onion skins? Placing acorn hats on your fairies? Making stick dolls? This is the challenge for you. This challenge incorporates items found in the natural world in your doll. The more natural elements, the more you meet the challenge.

- 3. Dolls should not be over 30" high or 24" wide.
- **4. Entry Fee**: \$10.00 for first doll; \$5.00 per doll thereafter. Maximum: four entries. Non-refundable. **Check or money order should be made to Wiltwyck Quilt Guild** (includes insurance up to \$200*.)
- **5**. Dolls may be for sale. 10% of sale price goes to the **Wiltwyck Quilt Guild**, so please take this into account when pricing your work. It is also okay to display work that is NFS (not for sale).
- **6**. All shipped dolls must be received by Oct 3rd by **Denise Giardullo**, **14 High Point View Rd**, **Stone Ridge**, **NY 12484**. An envelope with return postage costs (including postal insurance) and a completed self-addressed return mailing label must be included with your entries. It is recommended that you ship dolls early. If delivering in person to the **RVMS**, the deadline is Oct 7th at 3 PM.
- **7**. An entry form (below) needs to be filled out for **each** doll. *Email Promise to Participate due Aug 1st to ensure name of doll-maker on promotional postcard*
- **8.** Each doll must have a secure label or tag attached with entry name, artist, phone number/email, and price of doll if applicable.
- **9**. All props must be labeled with entry and artist's name. All accessories must be securely attached. Doll must be securely packed.
- * The Wiltwyck Quilt Guild is providing insurance coverage for theft or irreparable damage up to \$200.00 per doll. Artists have the option to provide additional coverage for any doll valued above \$200.00 through (non-Guild) insurance, such as homeowners. In the event of total loss of goods as the direct result of natural causes, the total coverage per artist would be \$200.
