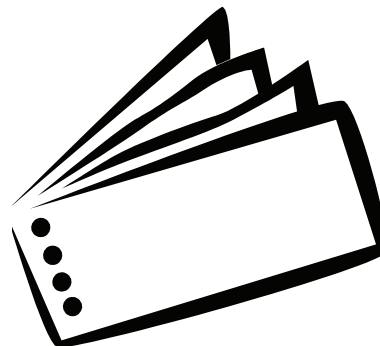
Alternatively you can go straight to <http://www.everydayhero.com.au/> and create your event and your home page and start raising funds alongside any sporting challenge you set for yourself.
