March 23, 2016-Watercolor*

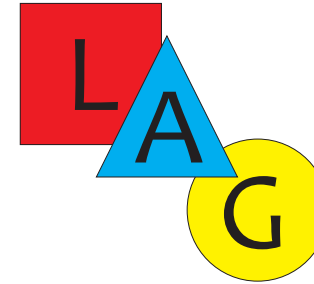
