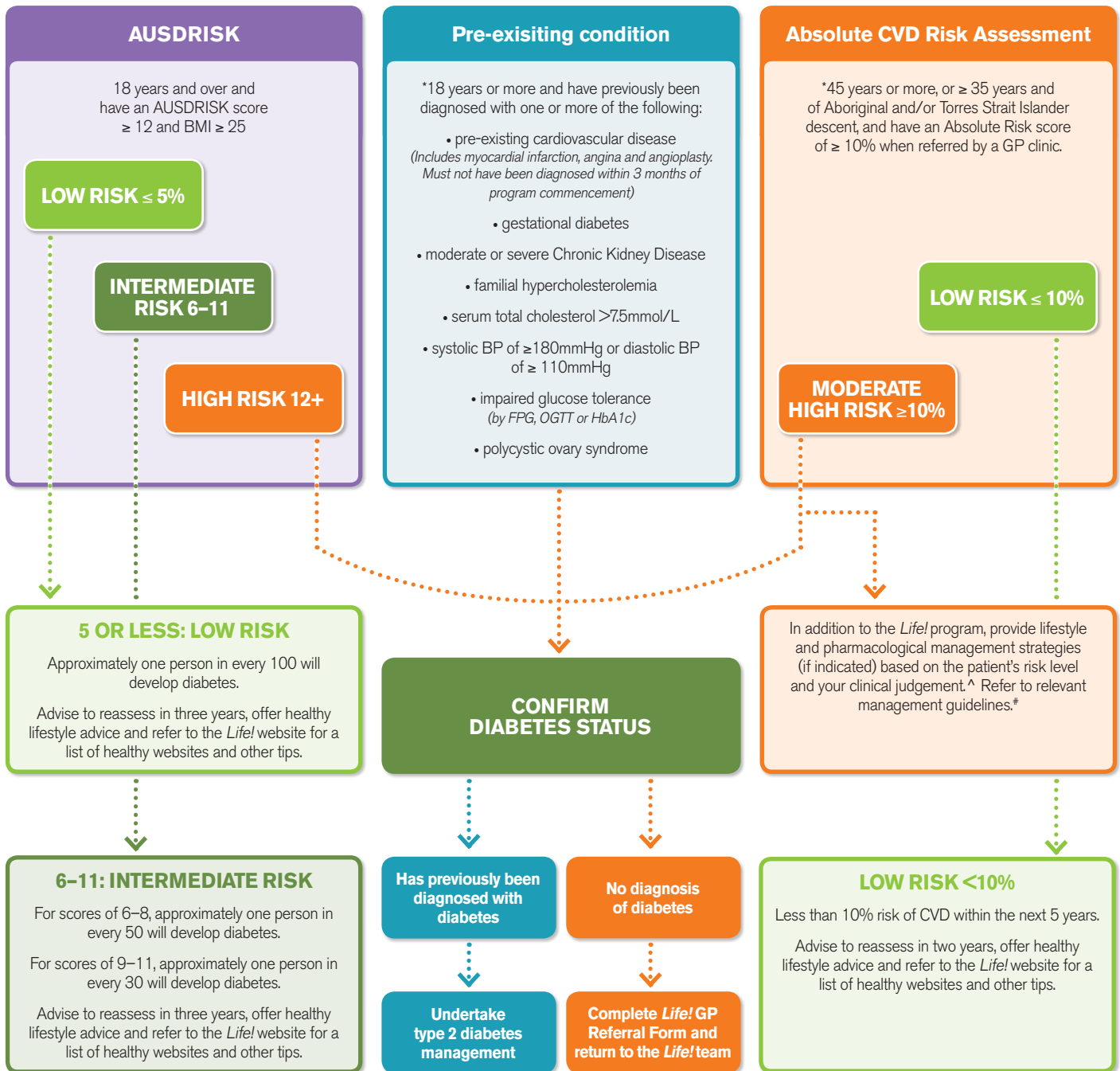


# PATIENT ELIGIBILITY AND REFERRAL PATHWAY
