- ✝ Joining by statement as a former Baptist or having been baptized by immersion as a believer.

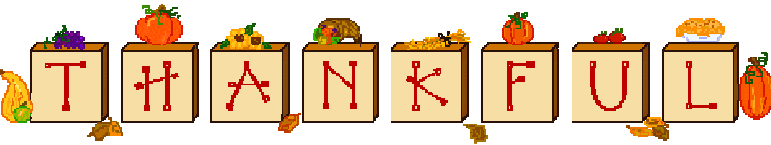

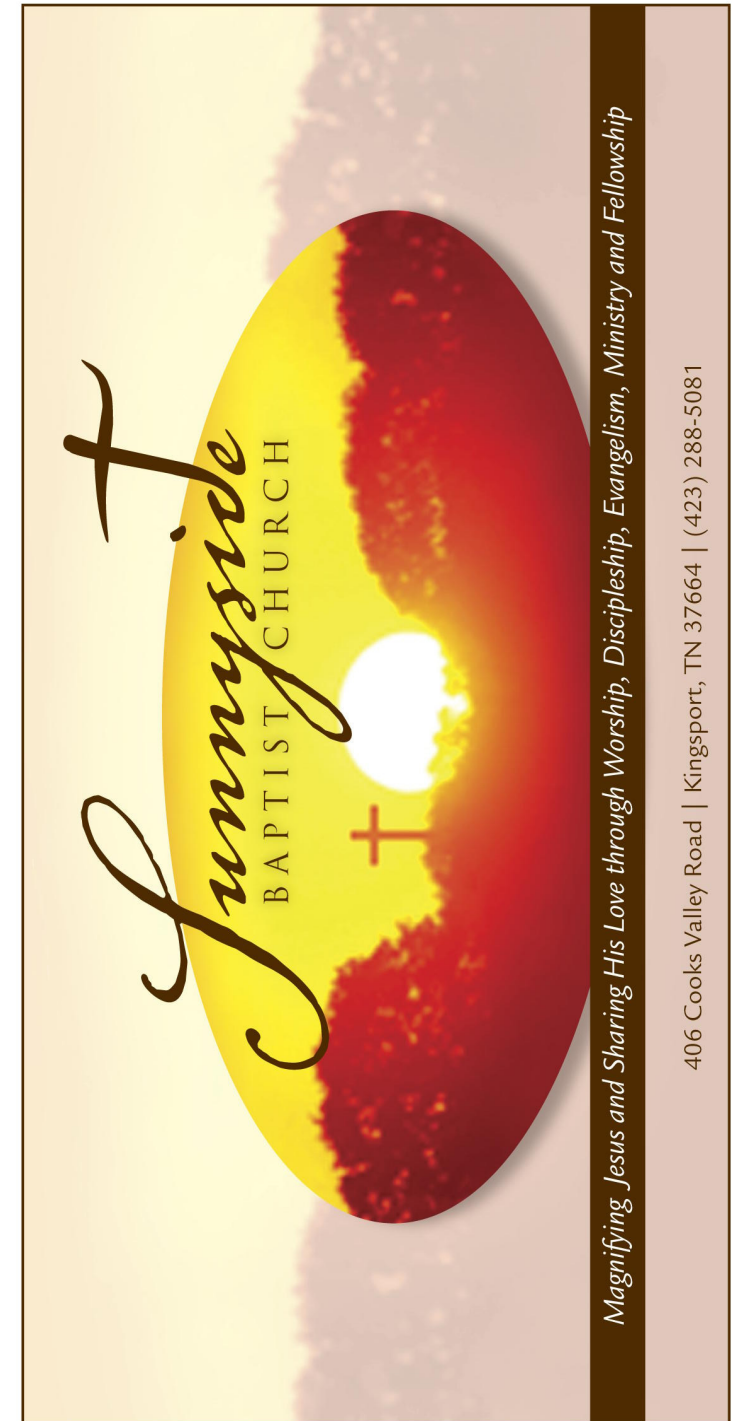
