Dear Club Member

At the start of the new season we would like to remind you of the following conditions for your child's involvement with the Club:

- All children should be properly equipped with boots with studs, shinpads and a waterproof jacket when appropriate. Children should have a drink and snack, and bring sunblock in summer, to both training sessions and matches.
- The Club does not act in *loco parentis* and officials take no parental responsibility for the children. All children playing for the Under 11s and younger age groups must be the responsibility of a named and present adult; this <u>cannot</u> be the manager or the coach.
- The Club is not responsible for the travel arrangements of children. If a parent is unable to travel with a child he/she must make provision for the safe transport of that child. The parent must inform the relevant Club official. Children playing for the Under 11s and younger are not permitted to travel unaccompanied.
- Any health/medication issues must be brought to the attention of the Club.
- Emergency contact telephone numbers must be provided to the Club.
- Club shirts, shorts and socks are the property of the Club. They should only be worn for Club matches and not at training sessions or other times.
- Club fees should be paid promptly by the dates given below. If you have difficulty in making a single payment it may be possible to pay in two installments, please contact your team manager about this. For the 2008/09 season the fees are as follows:

U14s, U12s, U11s, U10s, U9s, U8s: £60 (due on or before the first League game of the season)
U7s: £40 (due by 13 Sept 08 for existing members or after two trial sessions for new members)
U6s and younger: £25 (due by 13 Sept 08 for existing members or after two trial sessions for new members)
