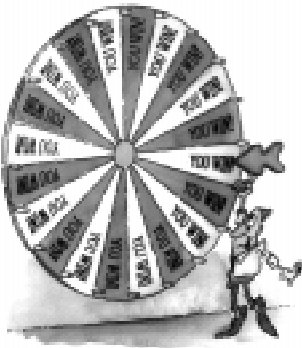

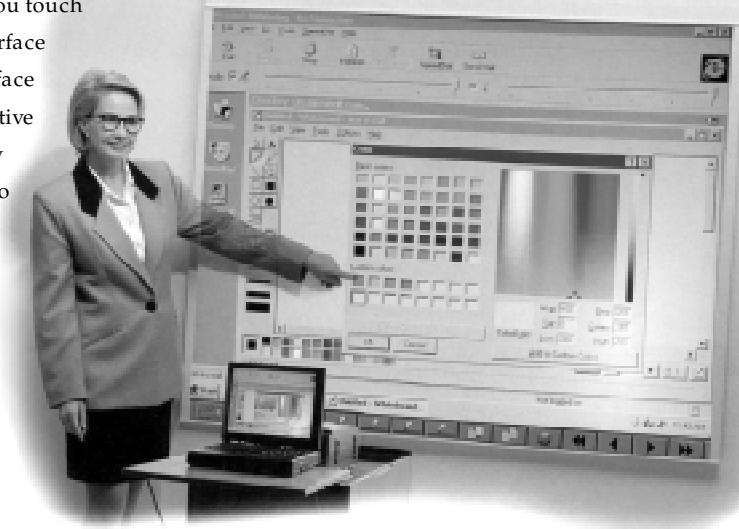

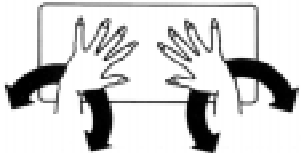
Health Tips - Developing Good Habits In Keyboarding

Avoid repetitive stress injuries. Contributing factors can include:

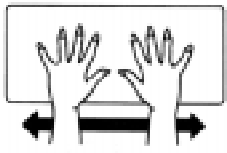
- Improper posture and wrist position
- Excessive force used on the keyboard
- Long term repetition
- Lack of variation in movements

Positive actions towards prevention are:

- Adjust keyboard tray height and angle to keep wrists in a neutral (straight) position
- Adjusting the keyboard to a negative incline position can help keep wrists in a neutral position
- Move entire hand, wrist and arm when reaching side to side
- Maintain good muscle tone and strength in your arms, shoulders, neck, and back
- Vary movements throughout the day
- Use no more force on keys than necessary
- See a health professional if hand, wrist or arm pain develops

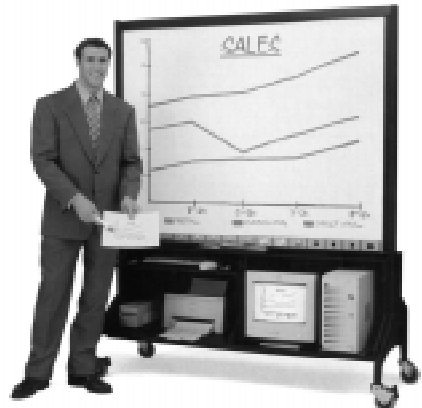

Parallel Teams

The organization is structured into specialized departments. For example, the marketing department consists of approximately 20 individuals. These team members are assembled for specific projects that require their specialized skills. The people work in parallel with their teammates to reach a common goal, but their paths cross when meetings and group work come up.



The project is not the team members' only job. The members belong to other teams and contribute their expertise to several projects which are generally in various stages of completion. As a result, team members are likely to be scattered in different locations or departments, but they need their space within the project as well.

Herman Miller's Puzzle Mobile Office: Setting up shop on the spot

Okay, so you can't check it with your luggage. But still, you can ship the Puzzle mobile office - the open office you can close up and take with you - almost anywhere you want to be.
