2. Follow directions on the instruction sheet (page 3) for online registration (make sure to sign up for transportation).
3. Print 2 copies of the receipt: 1 for you and 1 for Good Counsel Ski club.
4. Check instruction sheet for new picture (page 4). The instructions sheet is on the back of the registration instructions page if you need to send in a new picture (as this is the first time for the GC Ski club most of you will have to do this).
5. Fill out ALL forms required in this packet.
6. Return Completed forms to Peter Kotz, Head Athletic Trainer at Our Lady of Good Counsel High school. There will be a wait list until we get enough to fill each bus, so register early so that you are guaranteed a seat. If all forms are not filled out you will be bumped to the end of the list, which means you may not get on a bus. So...please fill out and sign ALL forms.
7. *Last day to get discounted rate is October 31st. After that date the rate goes up.*

## **Instructions for purchasing Your Whitetail Nightclub Card Online!**

**CLUB NAME: SHERWOOD**

**MEMBER PASSWORD: SkiTeen02**

**Go to [www.skiwhitetail.com/winter/groups/nconline](http://www.skiwhitetail.com/winter/groups/nconline)**

- Click the **RED** "purchase Today" button
- Type the club Name: **SHERWOOD** (case sensitive)
- Type in Password: **SkiTeen02** (case sensitive)
- The log in is case sensitive; enter name & password above exactly as listed.
- Select "Log In"
- Look in the lower left and select "**See Available Items**" under your club name.
- Select "**Nigh Club Cards**" (select Bus is mandatory)
- Select Age Category or select "night Season Pass" if you are buying that option.
- Select "**Yes**" or "**No**" for Advantage Card
- Select Card (Lift, Lift/Lesson, Lift/Lesson/Rental)
- Select Options: Helmet and or protection insurance (if you wish to add)
- Select "**Night Club Card**".
- Select "**Add to Cart**"
- **IF** you have never had a Whitetail pass or any type before, select "**Create New Guest**". **OR**, if you are a returning guest, follow the instructions under "**Existing Guests**" to look up and assign yourself to this pass. Note: when verifying birth date, use "MM/DD/YYYY".
- At this point you may upload or update the picture that will be printed on your Night Club Card. Instructions are provided. Please note that you may return at any time using the guest lookup function to update this step if you do not have a picture readily available. **However, in order for your Night Club Card to be printed, we must have an acceptable picture on file.**
- The next screen is "**Release & Liability**". Once you read and understand the agreement, check the box; once the page reappears, click the "Continue" button.
- Once you verify the contents of your cart and that your name has been properly assigned to your pass, click on "**Proceed to Checkout**" located under your sale total amount.
- Checking out consist of verifying your purchase, confirming your details and completing your final payment.
  - o Once your checkout has been completed, a confirmation page will appear. In order to get your card you must make a copy for the advisor
  - o Once you have competed your online purchase please make sure to download, fill out and turn in a hard copy release agreement form to your advisor. No Card will be issued until this is filled out and turned in.

### **Finally! And most Important!**

When you have completed the registration, make 2 copies. One copy is for your records and one to give to the GC Ski Club. **Attach the GC copy to all of the forms in the packet (Pages 5-9)**, fill out/ complete and sign all necessary GC forms (**pages 5-9**) and return them to Peter Kotz at Good Counsel in an envelope marked GC SKI CLUB. **DO NOT SEND ANY MONEY TO SCHOOL!**

**ALL registration needs are to be done on line and TURNED IN BY OCTOBER 31, 2012 to get reduced rate. No exceptions!**

**ALL forms must be completed to ensure your spot on the list for the buses. Incomplete forms will be bumped to the end of the list.**



## PHOTOS

**If you need a new photo on your account, you can have your photo taken at the resort , or you can upload a new one here!**

What is a good photo?

- The person should be full faced, front view, with eyes open.
- The person should NOT be wearing a hat, sunglasses, or any other accessories that block the face, eyes or head from view.
- The full frame photo should represent the person's head from top of hair to bottom of chin, without a lot of space around (you will be able to crop photo after it has been uploaded).
- The person should be against a relatively plain background.
- Be sure there is adequate lighting and there are no shadows across the face.
- The person's entire face should be in focus.

**NOTE: IF THE PHOTO DOES NOT MEET THE ABOVE GUIDELINES, YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE A PHOTO TAKEN AT THE RESORT. THE RESORT WILL NOT PRINT YOUR PASS WITH AN UNACCEPTABLE PHOTO.**

***Your Photo should be less than 1 MB in size – you will be able to crop it after you upload it.***

How to upload your photo:

1. Make sure you can locate your photo on your computer.
2. Click the "Upload Photo" button.
3. Browse to your photo and then select upload.
4. Once your photo had uploaded, select "Use this photo".
5. A window will appear to the right of your photo – this is a preview of how your final picture will look.
6. Use your mouse to click and drag the crosshair to crop your picture to meet the guidelines above.
7. When you are happy with the picture, click the "That's Good Let's Go!" button to save your picture to your account. Once you have clicked your old picture is gone for good, so be sure you are happy with it! If you aren't happy with the picture you have selected you can "Cancel" and browse your computer for another picture.

If you add without verification, you will not be able to view and update guest information such as address, email & phone number. The resort asks that you double check and update this information so we are best able to serve you.

## **Our Lady of Good Counsel High School Ski Club Rules & Policies Contract**

Our goal is to provide a safe and fun experience for OLGCHS students wishing to ski/snowboard whether they are a beginner or expert. In order to create this environment the following rules and guidelines listed below must be followed and we must have the full support and cooperation of each student and their parents. If you believe that you cannot abide by these rules, then please do not participate in the GCHS Ski Club.

1. Fees are charged for each activity to cover the cost of transportation, admission etc...
2. Any student who has been suspended from school or who has violated a major school rule will not be permitted to participate in OLGCHS Ski Club activities.
3. Anyone possessing alcoholic beverages, tobacco or illegal drugs of any sort at a club event may be turned over to the local police. Parents of anyone who is in possession and/or appears to have been using drugs or alcohol before or during a club event will be notified immediately. In such an event the parent will be expected to come and pick up the child at that time as the student will be separated from the club activity and will be sent home. Additionally, the student's privilege to participate will be revoked for the remainder of the school year.
4. Parents are expected to pick up students promptly from club events. Failure to do so will result in a loss of privileges. Under no circumstances will a chaperone/club moderator drive a student home.
5. Students should not bring valuables with them to OLGCHS Ski Club events. The OLGCHS Ski Club will not be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items during OLGCHS Ski Club events.
6. Students arriving for a OLGCHS Ski Club event/trip will be expected to attend that event. Students who arrive for an event and go elsewhere will not be allowed to attend future OLGCHS Ski Club events. Parents will be notified in all cases that are observed.
7. It is the responsibility of ALL students participating in OLGCHS Ski Club trips to listen to and follow all instructions of the adult chaperones on the trip. Failure to do so can cause inconvenience to everyone and possible danger to those who fail to listen and obey instructions. Students who continually do not follow instructions will not be permitted to participate in future events.
8. Refunds for OLGCHS Ski Club events/trips will be given only if a suitable replacement (another student) is found no less than 24 hours prior to the event/trip.
9. All Our Lady of Good Counsel High School rules and policies (as stated in the OLGCHS Student handbook) apply for all OLGCHS Ski Club events/trips. Additionally, all county, state, and national laws are in effect during OLGCHS Ski Club events/trips.
10. The OLGCHS Ski Club reserves the right to refuse admittance to any OLGCHS Ski Club event/trip based upon an individual student's past behavior.

**PROGRAM LIABILITY RELEASE AGREEMENT**

1. I agree on behalf of myself and/or the minor user I am representing to accept for use, AS IS all equipment to be provided, for the duration of this program and accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in the user's possession. I will be responsible for replacement at full value, for any equipment not returned by the agreed date and time.
2. I understand that breakage insurance applies to equipment breakage only, not lost, misplaced, or stolen equipment.
3. I or the minor I am representing will not use any equipment provided until instruction has been received and its use and function are fully understood.
4. I will make no misrepresentations concerning my or the minor's height, weight, age or skier/boarder type.
5. I agree that at each session I or an authorized designee will verify that the visual indicator settings recorded on the rental form agree with the numbers appearing in the visual indicator windows of the equipment listed on the form.
6. I understand that a ski-binding-boot system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the ski-binding-boot system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release and therefore, provides no guarantee of safety. In snowboarding, skiboarding, snowshoeing and other sports utilizing equipment with non-releasable bindings, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during normal operation.
7. I fully understand and agree that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, skiboarding, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and other sports, including the use of lifts (collectively "RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS") involve inherent and other risks that could lead to permanent catastrophic injury or death, and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of the sport, therefore, I freely and voluntarily assume for myself and/or the minor I am representing all the risk involved in RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS, or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment.
8. I AGREE NOT TO SUE, TO RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY and DEFEND Ski Liberty Operating Corp., Ski Roundtop Operating Corp. and Whitetail Mountain Operating Corp., their owners, agents and employees, as well as the equipment manufacturers and distributors and their successors in interest (collectively "PROVIDERS"), from all liability for injury, death, property loss or damage, that in any way results from the use of facilities or participation in recreational snow sports or is in any way related to the use of the equipment issued to the user, including liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE OF PROVIDERS or any other cause.
9. I understand that a helmet designed for recreational snow sports use may help reduce the risk of some types of injuries. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low-energy and high-energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.
10. I agree on behalf of myself or the minor child I am representing to report all injuries to the Ski Patrol before leaving the area.
11. I agree that all disputes arising under this contract, either for the use of rental equipment as described on the rental form, or for the use of the facilities, shall be litigated exclusively in the Court of Common Pleas of the County where the incident took place or in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania.
12. This agreement is governed by the applicable laws of this state. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall be given full force and effect.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THE ABOVE LIABILITY RELEASE AS WELL AS, THE RESPONSIBILITY CODE, CODE OF CONDUCT, SKIER TYPE CLASSIFICATION AND OTHER INFORMATION PROVIDED ONLINE . ## CODE OF CONDUCT

Violation of our guidelines can and will result in the loss of privileges without warning or refund.

Please...

- Be courteous and polite to other guests and employees at all times.
- Ski/board in a safe, responsible manner.
- Don't ski/board fast or in a reckless manner. Observe all posted signs.
- Do not use foul or offensive language, comments or gestures.
- Do not throw snowballs or other items at any time or place, including from lifts or in lift lines.
- Understand and abide by "Your Responsibility Code" at all times.

For the benefit of everyone, all resort employees are here to help you. We appreciate your assistance in keeping Whitetail Resort, Roundtop Mountain, and Liberty Mountain Resort enjoyable for everyone.

## YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above. Stop only on the side of the trail.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely. Do not jump from the lift. In the event of a prolonged stoppage, the Ski Patrol will evacuate you.
8. If you have a collision resulting in an injury to another person, it is your responsibility to stay at the collision site until the Ski Patrol arrives.
9. No Jumping or Aerial Maneuvers Allowed.
10. Do not go down trails that are too difficult for your ability level.
11. Skiing/Snowboarding is a positive environmental experience. Every effort should be made to care for the environment while enjoying the sport of skiing. Please do not litter.
12. All skiers are responsible for their own equipment and personal belongings.

Whitetail is not responsible for lost or stolen equipment.

REMEMBER: Ski Patrol and Mountain Host Staff members are available to give a short safety speech when your group arrives for its first ski session. If you would like your group to be addressed, please notify The Whitetail Sales Office prior to your arrival. The staff of the sales office is also available to come speak to your school or organization. Please feel free to contact us.
