ACT/ SAT Combination Practice Test



It is with great pleasure that NDHS is offering, through Kaplan Test Preparation program, a Practice ACT/SAT Combination Test. This ACT/SAT Combination Practice Test is being offered to students considering taking either the ACT or SAT test during their high school career. This test is a combination of both the ACT and SAT. The student should be better able to determine their testing preference by gauging their results in the designated sections. The practice test mimics the testing conditions of the ACT and SAT in length (approximately 4 ½ hours), classroom setting, and with breaks that are the same length as the actual test. This process allows students to become comfortable with the testing conditions prior to actually taking the real test.

To register for this test, a student must complete the form below and submit it with \$10 cash (no checks or other form of payment will be accepted) attached to the form and given to Mr. Collier or placed in the large envelope outside Mr. Collier's office in the Guidance office no later than noon Thursday, January 10. There are no refunds should the student decide not to attend or is unable to attend. In case of inclement weather and the necessity to reschedule, no refunds will be given if the student is unable to attend the rescheduled date. As this is a practice test, no extra time for students with disabilities will be given. Spaces are limited so registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Students are to come to Notre Dame High School no later tha 7:30 am on January 12. Students are to bring their calculator and at least two #2 sharpened pencils. No calculators or pencils will be available. Students will be assigned their proctor in the auditorium and escorted to their room for the test. Generally the test ends by 12:30 pm.
