

Technology and Learning Team Leaders

Selection:

Campus principals appoint one full time teacher at each grade level (K-5) to serve as the Technology and Learning Team Leader (TL2) that grade level.

TL2's must teach in the grade level for which they serve as a TL2.

Payment for TL2 Service:

Each TL2 teacher will receive two lump sum payments (one at the end of each semester) for active participation in the required, scheduled TL2 events.

TL2 Selection Deadline:

Once the selection process has been completed at the campus level, **the principal and teachers sign this Technology and Learning Team Leader Contract Agreement form** and return it to Ann McMullan at the KIC no later than **Friday, May 2.**

The Role of a TL2 in a Professional Learning Community

The position of a TL2 exists to create a professional learning community that:

- Assures that all students are taught and master the Technology Applications TEKS (TATEKS) using *EasyTech* from Learning.com and the Klein ISD TATEKS Scope and Sequence.
- Supports the campus efforts to assure that all professional educators are provided ample opportunities & support to master the SBEC technology standards for all teachers.
- Shares information from the District TL2 PLC with the teachers on their grade level team.

Required Duties of a TL2

1. **Lead** the collaboration efforts involving all teachers on the grade level team to plan and teach lessons that integrate the Technology Applications TEKS (TATEKS) into core content instruction, using *EasyTech* from Learning.com and following the KISD scope and sequence for technology applications for each nine weeks.
2. **Be a model teacher** by teaching the Technology Applications TEKS to your own students, using the *EasyTech* online tutorials and activities as specified in the KISD technology applications scope and sequence.
3. **Serve** on campus Technology Professional Development Leadership Team that targets mastery of the *SBEC Teacher Technology Standards for all Educators*.
4. **Share** information from the district TL2 PLC with the teachers on the grade level team.
5. **Participate fully** in ongoing professional development including TL2 online professional development, and campus study groups.

All TL2s are issued a Klein ISD laptop computer. TL2s will use the laptops to complete the required online professional development and technology integration efforts. Laptops will be returned to KISD when a teacher resigns from the TL2 position.
