This scholarship is open to the child, step-child, adopted child, grandchild, or great grandchild of any member in good standing of CATD-RTC. Such member must be a member in good standing for a period of not less than 5 continuous years. Applicants must be a lawful Canadian citizen or legal immigrant AND provide written proof of acceptance to, or be enrolled in, full-time studies at a recognized Canadian college, university, or institute of technology.

The scholarship has a value of \$500 and will be awarded on the basis of all-round achievement, rather than for strictly academic performance. Achievement in the areas of academics, athletics, the arts, and community will be considered, as well as the question of financial need, in determining the successful candidate.

The decision of the CATD-RTC Scholarship Committee will be considered to be final. The successful candidate must provide written verification of their acceptance into or participation in their stated program before funds will be advanced. Acceptance of this award is conditional upon consent to publish the recipient's name in the CATD-RTC Clearance.
